UPDATE ON CROSSLIN PARK SOFTBALL FIELDS.

Cory Buller stated the softball fields are coming along, drainage is done, waiting on fence contractors to come in after the surveying is completed, and a little bit of dirt work needs to be finished then they will be able to order sod by the end of next week.

DISCUSS OCTOBER 13, 2018 CULTURAL CELEBRATION.

Kim Haley informed of what vendors that will be at the event. The event starts at 2 pm and will go until 6 pm. There are still a couple of vendors that have not responded back yet. The Enid Choir will be there to sing and there are a couple of churches that have inquired to sing at the event as well. Tricia Mitchell asked if there was going to be a different meeting on this topic. Kim Haley stated that there is going to be a meeting to discuss the timeline of the program at 10 am on September 24th, at the Parks and Recreation building located at 1110 West Spruce.

DISCUSS FALL LEAGUE FIELD PREPARATIONS.

Cory Buller stated that they are well into the fall league preparations. Adult softball is playing at Kellet Park, soccer is in full swing and football starts this evening. Youth softball plays once a week on Sundays, soccer plays every day of the week, and adult softball plays one day a week.

DISCUSS PARK MAINTENANCE AND IMPROVEMENTS AND MAKE ANY RECOMMENDATIONS.

Tammy Wilson asked when Phillips Park in Southern Heights will be mowed. She stated that the grass was twelve inches tall about two weeks ago. Cory Buller stated it is on the list to be mowed and that it should be done today or tomorrow at the latest. Tricia Mitchell mentioned that due to the amount of rain recently it has been very difficult to mow. Cory Buller went on to state that they did an overnight run of the Downtown area from Maple Street to Owen K Garriott and from Washington Street to the railroad tracks to get everything cleaned up and looking good for the Cherokee Strip celebration that is this Saturday.

DISCUSS MOWING, TRIMMING, AND EDGING OF PARKS, TRAILS, AND DOWNTOWN LOCATIONS.

Cory Buller stated that they are behind on mowing, trimming and edging of the parks and trails due to the amount of rain we have had in the last week. He stated it is hard to stay caught up and not do any damage to grounds or equipment after it has rained so much.

UPDATE ON GOVERNMENT SPRINGS SOUTH FOOTBALL FIELD.

Cory Buller stated that the football fields are all in really good shape and will be fine tuning small things today. They have all of the irrigation installed and wired. There is new signage up along the fences and up on the score board. New sod was laid in the concourse area and where the irrigation was placed. The new buildings at the field are up and completed. Everett Glenn added that everything has been repainted. Cory Buller stated that a lot of work has been done to the area and it looks really great.

UPDATE ON CLOSING CHAMPLIN POOL FOR THE SEASON.

Kim Haley informed that Champlin pool has been closed for the season. They hosted the doggy dip last Saturday and they had a total of 38 dogs at the pool. They closed the season with six thousand and fifty-nine people. Cory Buller stated that the pool is currently being drained.

UPDATE ON RENAMING DON HASKINS PARK.

Cory Buller stated that the park at 5th and Maine is officially named Don Haskins Park.

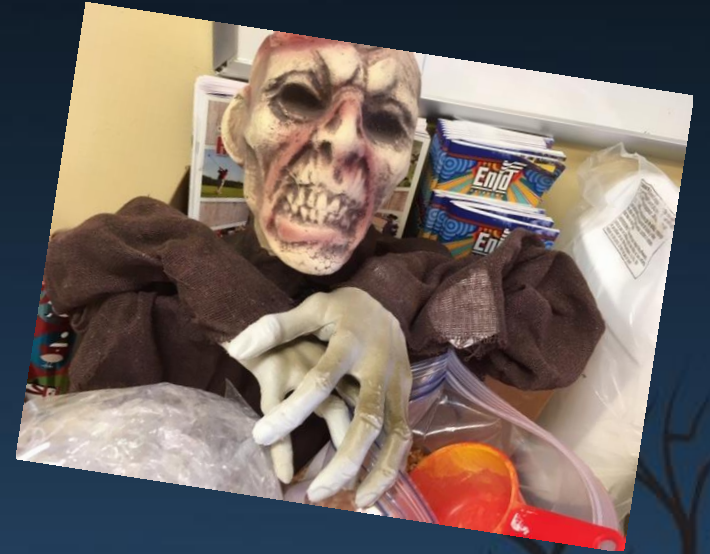

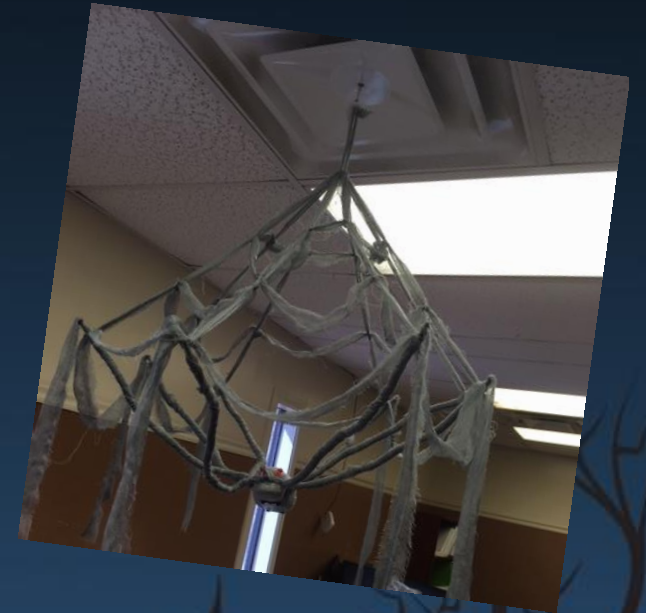
