BACKGROUND:

Enid Public Schools is rezoning eight properties from R-4 to SU Special Use District to be utilized for Enid High School parking. The properties are 417, 421 and 423 West York, 909 South Jefferson, 402, 406, 420 and 424 West Indiana.

Envision Enid Comprehensive Plan land use classification is Redeveloping Neighborhoods. Redeveloping Neighborhoods are also predominantly residential, but should be targeted for special reinvestment efforts in order to correct for a previous pattern of disinvestment. By reinvesting in these areas, Enid is able to fully leverage its existing infrastructure and ensure a complete and even development pattern.

The Engineering Department reviewed the rezoning and found the existing infrastructure, water, sewer and roads, to be adequate for the request rezoning.

CONSIDER A REZONING FOR PROPERTY LOCATED IN THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER (SW/4) OF SECTION 1, TOWNSHIP 22 NORTH, RANGE 8 WEST OF THE INDIAN MERIDIAN AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF CHESTNUT AND HIGHWAY 132 FOR CLINT BEAGLEY FROM I-3 HEAVY INDUSTRIAL DISTRICT TO A-1 GENERAL AGRICULTURE DISTRICT.

BACKGROUND:



CONSIDER A USE BY REVIEW FOR SKELETON CREEK WIND, LLC FOR 35 MILES OF TRANSMISSION LINES, 117 POLES, WITHIN MAPC JURISDICTION.

BACKGROUND:

This petition concerns overhead transmission lines located within MAPC jurisdiction, in the City Limits of Enid and Garfield County, OK.

The applicant is seeking a Use by Review approval for 117 structures (poles) that range in height from 80-feet to 120-feet tall. The transmission line is part of the Skeleton Creek Wind Farm project.

Vance Air Force Base has reviewed the transmission line locations and heights and determined the development will not interfere with operations at Vance Air Force Base. Woodring Regional Airport has reviewed and determined there will be no interference on operations at Woodring. The Department of Defense (DoD) Military Aviation and Installation Assurance Siting Clearinghouse (Clearinghouse) reviewed and found no adverse impacts to DoD missions in the area.





I have reviewed the Skeleton Creek Transmission line notice criteria letter dated 13 Jun 2019. The height of the transmission lines and towers, as proposed, will not interfere with Enid Woodring Regional Airport operations. The only risk this may cause would be from radio interference, and we do not hold any responsibility or expertise for that type of determination. However, since there is already a power station in the location proposed, we are assuming that it will not change the current outputs or potential interferences.
