REVIEW A SIGN REQUEST FOR PROPERTY LOCATED AT 2327 WEST OWEN K. GARRIOTT ROAD, TO DETERMINE IF THE PROPOSED SIGN CAN BE LOCATED IN AN EASEMENT UNDER SECTION 11-13-9(D) OF THE ENID MUNICIPAL CODE (EMC), SPECIFIC ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT OPPORTUNITIES, AND TAKE APPROPRIATE ACTION.

BACKGROUND:

A new Jiffy Trip will be constructed at 2327 West Owen K. Garriott Road. The property is zoned C-3 General Commercial District. The applicant is seeking to locate the monument sign in the northwest corner of the property in the landscape strip, which is also designated as a 50-foot access easement. The proposed monument sign is prohibited from being in the access easement pursuant to Section 11-13-5A.3 of the Enid Municipal Code 2014. See the attached site plan.

This request is made pursuant to Section 11-13-9(d) of the Enid Municipal Code 2014, which allows the City Commission to review and approve proposed signs that are not in strict compliance with the Enid Municipal Code 2014 when, because of specific economic development considerations, would be in the interest of the City.





BACKGROUND:

This ordinance was reviewed at the February 4, 2020 Study Session. The State has transitioned from allowing tags on vehicles to be transferred with the vehicle to the new owner, to requiring the new owner to tag the car within 5 days of the transfer. As part of this transition, the State requires operators to keep a registration certificate in the motor vehicle to exhibit to a police officer on demand. This ordinance mirrors state law. The penalty for violation is a maximum fine of \$300.00, plus costs.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ENID MUNICIPAL CODE, 2014, TITLE 6, ENTITLED MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC CHAPTER 1, ENTITLED GENERAL TRAFFIC PROVISIONS TO ADD SECTION 6-1-15 ENTITLED DOCUMENTS REQUIRED DURING OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLE TO REQUIRE REGISTRATION TO BE IN VEHICLE WITH EXCEPTION AND PENALTY; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER, SAVINGS CLAUSE, SEVERABILITY AND CODIFICATION.

ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ENID, OKLAHOMA:

<u>Section I</u>: That Title 6, Chapter 1, Section 6-1-15 of the Enid Municipal Code, 2014, is to read as follows:

6-1-15: DOCUMENTS REQUIRED DURING OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLE¹

A. No person shall operate a motor vehicle, without having one of the following documents in the motor vehicle which upon demand is to be exhibited to a police officer:

- 1. Registration certificate or an official copy thereof;
- 2. True copy of rental or lease documentation issued for a motor vehicle:
- 3. Registration certificate or an official copy thereof issued for a replacement vehicle in the same registration period;
- 4. Temporary receipt printed upon self-initiated electronic renewal of a registration via the Internet; or
- 5. Cab card issued for a vehicle registered under the International Registration Plan.
- B. Exception: The provisions of subsection A of this section shall not apply during the first thirty days after purchase of a motor vehicle.

C. Penalty: A violation of this section is punishable by a maximum fine of \$300.00, plus costs.

<u>Section II.</u> Repealer. All ordinances or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with this ordinance, are hereby repealed.

<u>Section III</u>: Savings Clause. Nothing in this ordinance hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceedings now pending in any court, or any rights acquired or liability incurred, nor any cause or causes of action accrued or existing, under any act or ordinance repealed hereby. Nor shall any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this ordinance.

<u>Section IV:</u> Severability. If any one or more of the sections, sentences, clauses or parts of this ordinance, chapter or section shall, for any reason, be held invalid, the invalidity of such section, clause or part shall not affect or prejudice in any way the applicability and validity of any other provision of this ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Commission of the City of Enid that this section of the Enid Municipal Code would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part not been included.

<u>Section V</u>: Codification. This ordinance shall be codified as Title 6, Chapter 1, Section 6-1-15 of the Enid Municipal Code, 2014.

BACKGROUND:

State law provides that no alcoholic beverages shall be sold, served, or consumed on the premises between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. (37A O.S. § 3-125 (A)). It also allows municipalities to enact ordinances that require on premise licensees to be closed to the public between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. The Police Department has requested this ordinance because some bars are staying open after 2:00 a.m., and enforcement of the state law that restricts sale, service, and consumption after 2:00 a.m. would be easier to monitor if the bars were required to close at 2:00 a.m. This ordinance was reviewed at the February 4, 2020 Study Session.

ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ENID, OKLAHOMA:

<u>Section I</u>: That Title 5, Chapter 5, Article H, Section 5-5H-2 of the Enid Municipal Code, 2014, is hereby amended to read as follows:

5-5H-2: ALCOHOL RESTRICTIONS; INTOXICATION:

Definitions: As used in this section, the following words and phrases shall have the meanings respectfully ascribed to them in this section:

ALCOHOL: Means and includes hydrated oxide of ethyl, ethyl alcohol, ethanol or spirits of wine, from whatever source or by whatever process produced. It does not include wood alcohol or alcohol which has been denatured or produced as denatured in accordance with Acts of Congress and regulations promulgated thereunder.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE: Means alcohol, spirits, beer and wine as those terms are defined by 37A of the Oklahoma Statutes and also includes every liquid or solid, patented or not, containing alcohol, spirits, wine or beer and capable of being consumed as a beverage by human beings.

LICENSEE: Means any person holding a license under the Oklahoma Alcoholic Beverage Control Act, and any agent, servant or employee of such licensee while in the performance of any act or duty in connection with the licensed business or on the licensed premises.

A. Public Intoxication¹:

1. No person shall be drunk or intoxicated on any public or private road, or in any public conveyance, or any public place or building, or at any public gathering, from drinking or consuming any alcoholic beverage, intoxicating substance, intoxicating compound, or

from inhalation of glue, paint, or other intoxicating substance. No person shall be drunk or intoxicated from any cause and shall disturb the peace of any person.

2. The violation of this subsection shall be punishable by a fine of not less than ten dollars (\$10.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) plus costs.

B. Consumption Of Alcohol:

- 1. No person shall consume or possess any alcoholic beverage in any street, alley or other public place, except:
 - a. As authorized as part of a special event pursuant to section 1-15-9 of this Code; or,
 - b. Wine and beer in City owned parks.
- 2. The violation of this subsection shall be punishable by a fine of not less than ten dollars (\$10.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) plus costs.

(Ord. 2018-23, 8-21-2018, eff. 10-1-2018)

C. Hours of Operation²:

- 1. No licensee who provides alcoholic beverages for consumption on premises may open before 6:00 AM or close later than 2:00 AM.
- 2. The violation of this subsection shall be punishable by a fine of five hundred (\$500.00), plus costs.

<u>Section II.</u> Repealer. All ordinances or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with this ordinance, are hereby repealed.

<u>Section III</u>: Savings Clause. Nothing in this ordinance hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceedings now pending in any court, or any rights acquired or liability incurred, nor any cause or causes of action accrued or existing, under any act or ordinance repealed hereby. Nor shall any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this ordinance.

<u>Section IV:</u> Severability. If any one or more of the sections, sentences, clauses or parts of this ordinance, chapter or section shall, for any reason, be held invalid, the invalidity of such section, clause or part shall not affect or prejudice in any way the applicability and validity of any other provision of this ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Commission of the City of Enid that this section of the Enid Municipal Code would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part not been included.

The Oklahoma Development Finance Authority administers the program and the Oklahoma Department of Commerce scores the applications and performs the assessment of the size of the incentive to ensure it is net benefit neutral to the State. The City is working on an application for funding assistance through this program for the number one priority for Vance Air Force Base, which is a new enlisted housing dormitory facility, which the City would build, own, and lease to the Air Force. The project currently contemplates using the funds generated for one year as a portion of the cost of building the facility. The Air Force contemplates leasing this facility for at least ten years, and funding for the entire facility will be secured prior to moving forward this this project.




