City of Enid COVID-19 Response Update 03-18-2020

ENID, OK (March 18, 2020) –

The City of Enid is taking further precautions in response to the COVID-19 pandemic in an effort to minimize the potential community spread of the virus. Beginning Thursday, March 19, 2020, the City Administration building will be closed to the public, however, employees will continue to provide essential services to serve the public.

Residents are encouraged to utilize services online, by phone, by mail, by drop box, or by email. For services that require in-person communication, contact the department for an appointment time and date. See a staff listing at www.enid.org/staff and for a department listing www.enid.org/contactus.

Municipal court will continue at regular times and dates, but appearances will occur by telephone or by other remote means.

Additionally, the Stride Bank Center, Senior Center and RSVP are closed to the public effective March 19, 2020. Staff will continue to work in those facilities to provide services to the public. Mobile meals will continue to be provided.

In accordance with the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidance, all events or community gatherings more than 10 people should be cancelled or postponed through the end of the current emergency declaration on April 13, 2020. This declaration may be extended further based on the future situation. Individual businesses in Enid are taking proactive steps, following the CDC guidelines.
