## CITY OF ENID, OKLAHOMA EMERGENCY DECLARATION COVID-19 MARCH 20, 2020

## PURSUANT TO ENID MUNICIPAL CODE 2014, TITLE 5, CHAPTER 3, SECTIONS 5-3-1 THROUGH 5-3-10 AND 63 O.S. 683.11.

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization (WHO) has declared COVID-19 (Coronavirus) to be a global pandemic; the President of the United States has declared an infectious disease national emergency declaration to combat COVID-19; The State of Oklahoma and the City of Enid have declared states of emergency; and

WHEREAS, the spread of COVID-19 is a disaster affecting life, health, and safety of Enid residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of Enid Municipal Code 2014, Title 5, Public Safety, Chapter 3, Emergency Management, Sections 5-3-1 through 5-3-10, and 63 O.S. §683.11 permit the City Manager, to promulgate emergency regulations during a state of emergency within the City of the Enid.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT DETERMINED THAT THE FOLLOWING EMERGENCY REGULATIONS WILL GO INTO EFFECT SATURDAY, MARCH 21, 2020, AT 11:59PM.

## **Emergency Regulation #2020-1**

<u>Section I.</u> Federal protocols now urge communities to cancel gatherings of 10 people or more whenever possible. Therefore, all social gatherings of more than ten are prohibited.

Section II. Religious services are limited to gatherings of ten or less.

Section III. Public restaurants are limited to drive through, take out, or delivery options.

<u>Section IV.</u> Bars, gyms, exercise facilities, miniature golf, bowling alleys, arcades, skating rinks, and movie theatres are closed to the public.

Section V. The regulations will expire April 13, 2020, at 11:59pm unless extended.
