

CITY OF ENID, OKLAHOMA COVID -19 DECLARATION
June 2, 2020

WHEREAS, the World Health Organization (WHO) has declared COVID-19 (Coronavirus) to be a global pandemic; the President of the United States has declared an infectious disease national emergency declaration to combat COVID-19 on March 13, 2020; The State of Oklahoma declared a state of emergency on March 15, 2020;

WHEREAS, the City of Enid declared a state of emergency on March 16, 2020;

WHEREAS, the spread of COVID-19 is a disaster affecting life, health, and safety of residents and visitors;

WHEREAS, on April 22, 2020 the Governor of the State of Oklahoma announced a state-wide plan “Open Up and Recover Safely”;

WHEREAS , the provisions of Enid Municipal Code 2014, Title 5, Public Safety, Chapter 3, Emergency Management, Sections 5-3-1 through 5-3-10, and 63 O.S. §683.11 permit the City Manager, to promulgate emergency regulations during a state of emergency within the City of the Enid.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT DETERMINED THAT THE FOLLOWING DECLARATION REPLACES ALL PREVIOUS PROCLAMATIONS OR DECLARATIONS AND WILL GO INTO EFFECT ON: Wednesday, June 3, 2020, at 8:00 a.m.

Section I. The City of Enid rescinds the state of emergency within the corporate limits of the City of Enid, Garfield County, Oklahoma.

Section II. The City has adopted the State of Oklahoma’s Open Up and Recover Safely Plan with the accompanying guidance and regulation found at <https://www.okcommerce.gov/wp-content/uploads/Open-Up-and-Recover-Safely-Plan.pdf>.
