ORDINANCE NO. 2013-18

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ENID MUNICIPAL CODE, 2003, TITLE 2, ENTITLED "FINANCE AND TAXATION," CHAPTER 6, ENTITLED "FEE SCHEDULE," ARTICLE C, ENTITLED "CITY SERVICES AND FACILITIES," SECTION 2-6C-3, ENTITLED "LIBRARY FEES AND ACCESS," TO EXPAND THE ROOMS WHICH THE LIBRARY MAY RENT; AMENDING TITLE 7, ENTITLED "PUBLIC WAYS AND PROPERTY," CHAPTER 10, ENTITLED "LIBRARY SECTION 7-10-5, ENTITLED "SCOPE OF DUTIES," TO REMOVE THE NAME OF THE LIBRARY ENDOWMENT FUND; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, REPEALER, **SAVINGS** CLAUSE, **AND** CODIFICATION.

ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ENID, OKLAHOMA:

<u>Section I</u>: That Title 2, Chapter 6, Article C, Section 2-6C-3 of the Enid Municipal Code, 2003, is hereby amended to read as follows:

2-6C-3: LIBRARY FEES AND ACCESS:

- A. Fees: The fees to be charged at the public library of Enid and Garfield County shall be set by the library board and shall be posted at the library, at the city hall administration building and on the library's website.
- B. Failure Tto Return Loaned Item: Any patron that has failed to return the loaned item(s) by the due date shall no longer have borrowing or other library privileges until the loaned item is returned, the appropriate fees have been paid, or other arrangements made.
- C. Renting <u>Great Plains</u> Room<u>s</u>: The following rates shall apply for renting the <u>Great Plains</u> Room<u>rooms</u> in the public library of Enid and Garfield County:

Nonprofit organization	No charge
For profit organization	\$25 .00

<u>Section I</u>: That Title 7, Chapter 10, Section 7-10-5 of the Enid Municipal Code, 2003, is hereby amended to read as follows:

7-10-5: SCOPE OF DUTIES:

The **bB**oard's duties shall include:

- A. Conducting hearings or meetings when needed;
- B. Annual review of the library budget to include recommendations concerning expenditures and projects;
- C. Reviewing, developing and adopting library policies that affect patrons, public service and the availability of services for residents throughout Garfield County;
- D. Developing a long term plan for the library, particularly as it relates to collection development, special programming, technology, infrastructure, and the Enid Foundation library endowment fund; and
- E. Making recommendations to the <u>eCity mManager</u> concerning the hiring, performance and retention of the library director. (Ord. 2008-25, 9-16-2008)

<u>Section III</u>: Repealer. All ordinances or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with this ordinance, are hereby repealed.

<u>Section IV</u>: Savings Clause. Nothing in this ordinance hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceedings now pending in any court, or any rights acquired or liability incurred, nor any cause or causes of action accrued or existing, under any act or ordinance repealed hereby. Nor shall any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this ordinance.

<u>Section V</u>: Severability. If any one or more of the sections, sentences, clauses or parts of this ordinance, chapter or section shall, for any reason, be held invalid, the invalidity of such section, clause or part shall not affect or prejudice in any way the applicability and validity of any other provision of this ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Commission of the City of Enid that this section of the Enid Municipal Code would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part not been included.

<u>Section VI</u>: Codification. This ordinance shall be codified as Title 2, Chapter 6, Article C, Section 2-6C-3 and Title 7, Chapter 10, Section 7-10-5 of the Enid Municipal Code, 2003.
