6.1 CONDUCT A PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING THE FIVE YEAR CONSOLIDATED PLAN, AND TO CONSIDER \$384,949.50 OF PROPOSED ALLOCATIONS FROM THE FISCAL YEAR 2013 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDING CYCLE AS RECOMMENDED BY THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDING COMMITTEE.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: The City of Enid, as an entitlement city for the receipt of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds, is required to submit an annual action plan for expenditure of funds to the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The amount of CDBG funds available to the City of Enid is determined by a formula administered by HUD.

Funding allocation amounts have yet to be determined. Due to the budget sequestration, the amount of the Fiscal Year 2013 CDBG allocation is estimated to be 5% less than the Fiscal Year 2012 allocation. The estimated amount is \$384,949.50.

The CDBG Funding Committee met and made a funding recommendation on March 8, 2013. The final decision on the proposed plan will be considered at the May 6, 2013, City Commission meeting.

<u>BACKGROUND:</u> This is a companion to Item 12.1. Charlie W. Stanley is an airport technician at Enid Woodring Regional Airport. On November 28, 2010, he injured his left calf while pushing an aircraft in heavy winds. This case subsequently resulted in surgery to the right hip, secondary to the left calf injury.

On October 11, 2012, Mr. Stanley reached maximum medical improvement and was returned to work with no permanent restrictions. The City offered and Mr. Stanley accepted a compromised settlement in the amount of \$20,366.00. The Court entered an order in favor of Mr.

Stanley for the above-stated amount, payable within 20 days of the order.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: This is a companion to Item 12.2. Michael D. Schatz is a driver with the Enid Fire Department. On August 19, 2012, he injured his lower back while lifting a heavy patient during a medical call and aggravated that injury while getting out of a chair. This case subsequently resulted in surgery to the lumbar spine.

On February 11, 2013, Mr. Schatz reached maximum medical improvement and was returned to work with no permanent restrictions. The City offered and Mr. Schatz accepted a compromised settlement in the amount of \$27,455.00. The Court entered an order in favor of Mr. Schatz for the above-stated amount, payable within 20 days of the order.

8.3 CONSIDER AN AGREEMENT WITH NORTHERN OKLAHOMA COLLEGE, TONKAWA, OKLAHOMA, TO LAY, MAINTAIN, AND OPERATE A COMMUNICATIONS LINE WITHIN THE CITY OF ENID RIGHT-OF-WAY.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: Northern Oklahoma College (NOC) submitted an application to lay, maintain, and operate a communications line housed in a four-inch (4") conduit within City of Enid owned right-of-way. The communications line is being installed to operate a fire warning system.

The application provides directional boring of East Maine Street, approximately 300 feet East of University Avenue. Payment in the amount of \$100.00 has been made for this crossing.

Upon approval of the agreement, the contractor for this project will be issued a permit to begin work.

8.4 CONSIDER AN AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES WITH WIGGINS AUCTIONEERS, LLC, ENID, OKLAHOMA, TO ACT AS THE WATER RIGHTS ACQUISITION AGENT FOR THE CITY OF ENID, PROJECT W-1304A.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: The City of Enid received a Water Master Plan Report indicating a need to acquire additional water supply. The plan is based on a 50-year view of demand, growth, and water availability. An agent on behalf of the City of Enid is necessary to contact and negotiate water rights with property owners for the acquisition of ground water.

The City received three (3) proposals. Wiggins Auctioneers was chosen as the best professional firm based on qualifications, experience, and knowledge of the process. Payment to Wiggins Auctioneers is based on a per acre amount for actual water rights acquired. Payment will be made after closing in an amount not to exceed \$250,000.00.

9.1 APPROVE AND EXECUTE CONTRACTS WITH RON'S MOWING SERVICE AND GIRLS GETTER DONE FOR THE MOWING AND CLEANING OF LOTS FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2013.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: The City of Enid abatement programs rely on private contractors to provide labor to eliminate the accumulation of high grass, weeds, trash and debris throughout the community. These contracts are awarded annually. Contractors are selected based on qualifications and price bid per lot to perform the required services. A minimum of two (2) contractors is required in order to adequately meet the City's abatement program's needs.

The City received three (3) bids and two (2) met specifications. Ron's Mowing Service was awarded a contract based on a per lot bid of \$75.00 for lots equal to or less than ¼ acre in size and a per lot bid of \$110.00

for lots more than a $\frac{1}{2}$ acre to $\frac{1}{2}$ acre in size. Girls Getter Done was awarded a contract based on a per lot bid of \$80.00 for lots equal to or less than $\frac{1}{2}$ acre in size and a per lot bid of \$175.00 for lots more than a $\frac{1}{2}$ acre to $\frac{1}{2}$ acre in size.

9.2 AWARD PROFESSIONAL CONTRACT FOR ENID WOODRING REGIONAL AIRPORT ENGINEERING SERVICES TO COBB ENGINEERING COMPANY, OKLAHOMA CITY, OKLAHOMA, AND AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTS AFTER REVIEW BY THE CITY ATTORNEY.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: The Federal Aviation Administration requires that an airport consultant engineer be reselected every five (5) years. The present consultant, Cobb Engineering Company, has performed these services for five (5) years. A Request for Qualifications was published, and Cobb Engineering Company was the only respondent.

The proposed contract was reviewed by the Enid Woodring Regional Airport Director and City Attorney and found to be acceptable. The contract amount will be amended based on work details for each project.

9.3 APPROVE CHANGE ORDER NO. 2 WITH S.L. MADISON CONSTRUCTION, LLC, CRESCENT, OKLAHOMA, AND ACCEPT THE 42ND STREET AND MARKET AVENUE DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT, PROJECT F-0905A.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: This project improved the drainage system along 42nd Street from Market Street to Boggy Creek by opening the channel and placing a new underground pipe system. This improves flood control at this intersection and ensures access to the new Water Reclamation Facility.

Change Order No. 2, in the amount of \$11,792.78, was necessary to realign and lower the pipe system to clear an Oklahoma Natural Gas high pressure gas line encountered during construction. The final contract amount is \$111,667.60.

This project is complete and has a three (3) year Maintenance Warranty.

9.4 APPROVE CHANGE ORDER NO. 1 WITH CONTINENTAL CONSTRUCTION CORPORATION, EDMOND, OKLAHOMA, FOR PHASE FOUR OF THE PEDESTRIAN TRAIL PROJECT, M-1201B.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: This project extends the foot trail located near Meadows Point Apartments 2,600 feet north on Cleveland Street to Garriott Road. Change Order No. 1, in the amount of \$14,743.72, will rebuild the curb inlets at South Cleveland Street and Indian Drive due to deterioration. The total revised contract amount is \$320,803.16.

9.5 ACCEPT A PUBLIC HIGHWAY EASEMENT FROM BRANDON TURNBOW, ENID, OKLAHOMA, FOR THE WILLOW ROAD WIDENING PROJECT, R-0303D.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: This public highway easement will provide additional right-of-way at Willow West Subdivision, and is required to widen Willow Road between Cleveland Street and Oakwood Road to four (4) lanes. The cost of this right-of-way is \$9,999.00, of which \$2,650.00 is for damages.

This acquisition was settled for a cost of \$11,000.00. However, Wells Fargo Bank holds a mortgage on this property and insists on applying the entire amount to the loan before issuing a mortgage release. The property owner does not agree.

The Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT) agreed to waive the requirement for a mortgage release if a settlement could be reached for less than \$10,000.00. The City of Enid assumes a risk of up to \$9,999.00 if Wells Fargo Bank forecloses on this easement.

9.6 APPROVE CHANGE ORDER NO. 2, AND ACCEPT THE PROJECT WITH YOUNG CONTRACTING, LLC, OKLAHOMA CITY, OKLAHOMA, FOR DOWNTOWN RENAISSANCE STREET IMPROVEMENTS, PHASE 1, R-1205A.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: This project provides pedestrian access from the new parking lots constructed at the Event Center and Convention Hall, which includes reconstruction of certain curbs and storm inlets. Completion is expected by the opening of the Event Center.

On March 19, 2013, the City Commission approved Change Order No. 1 to reduce the contract amount and correct work already completed. The remaining work will be completed by another existing contract.

Change Order No. 2 will add \$7,293.26 to the contract to adjust final quantities for all corrected work. The final contract amount is \$133,569.31.

This project is complete and has a three (3) year Maintenance Warranty.

9.7 APPROVE CHANGE ORDER NO. 4 WITH LUCKINBILL INC., ENID, OKLAHOMA, FOR THE SANITARY SEWER POINT REPAIRS, PROJECT S-1101A.

BACKGROUND: Luckinbill, Inc. was awarded a contract to perform sanitary sewer point repairs. The original contract amount was \$399,178.50. Change Order No. 1 added cleaning and television inspection of approximately 100,000 linear feet of lines in the amount of \$270,000.00. Change Order No. 2 added cleaning and television inspection of 229,000 linear feet of lines, upgraded camera equipment and software, and the completion of approximately ten (10) point repairs in the amount of \$750,000.00. Change Order No. 3 added \$125,000.00 for the completion of approximately 23 repairs and for adjusting quantities of work accomplished during Change Order No. 2. To date, Luckinbill, Inc. has completed 121 point repairs and inspected 321,612 linear feet of line. The current contract amount is \$1,544,178.50

Change Order No. 4, in the amount of \$125,000.00, will add 27 additional sanitary sewer point repairs, and adjust quantities of work completed in Change Order No. 3 to match quantities placed.

The revised contract amount is \$1,669,178.50. An additional 200 days will be added to complete the work.

9.8 APPROVE AN APPLICATION FOR 1318 NANCY DRIVE, ENID, OKLAHOMA, AS PART OF THE 2013 SANITARY SEWER DAMAGE AND BACKFLOW PREVENTION COST PARTICIPATION PROGRAM, PROJECT S-1314A.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: Section 2-6E (F) (3) of the City of Enid Municipal Code provides that residents may file for assistance in the case of repeated sanitary sewer damages to private property. When damages are a result of failure in the public system that cannot be reasonably solved by maintenance, and are not covered by insurance, the resident can apply for 50% of the total cost for repairs and installation of a backflow preventer.

Robert Hitchcock, resident at 1318 Nancy Drive, Enid, Oklahoma, reported damages caused by sanitary sewer back-ups on two (2) occasions: June 5, 2012, and October 30, 2012. He submitted a Tort Claim to Oklahoma Municipal Assurance Group (OMAG) on November 14, 2012, which was denied on January 8, 2013. On March 5, 2013, Mr. Hitchcock submitted an application for the Sanitary Sewer Damage and Backflow Prevention Cost Participation Program, supporting documentation, proof of backflow preventer installed, and a claim in the amount of \$4,854.88.

After review of plans, inspection videos and maintenance of the system, the resident's claim is found in order. This item is presented for payment of 50% of the total cost, \$2,427.44.

9.9 ACCEPT AN OKLAHOMA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY CONSTRUCTION PERMIT TO EXTEND THE WATERLINE AT 1200 EAST ASH AVENUE, ENID, OKLAHOMA, PROJECT NO. W-1303A.

<u>BACKGROUND:</u> The Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (ODEQ) approved a permit to construct 337 Linear Feet of 8-inch PVC water line to provide fire protection for Progressive Missionary Baptist Church at the corner of 12th Street and Ash Avenue.

Upon acceptance of Permit WL24130187, it will be recorded as permanent record and the private developer will be notified.

9.10 APPROVE CHANGE ORDER NO. 7 WITH WYNN CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, OKLAHOMA CITY, OKLAHOMA, FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE WATER RECLAMATION FACILITY, S-0703E.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: This project was awarded to Wynn Construction for \$33,478,000.00, a substantial savings from the estimated \$46,000,000.00. Work began in June 2010, allowing for \$2,900,000.00 in change orders. Six (6) change orders have been issued to date, in the amount of \$992,103.95 for a revised total contract amount of \$34,470,103.95.

Change Order No. 7 in the amount of \$55,685.13 will provide for the following:

1. Cost of additional concrete testing by Burgess Engineering to confirm concrete quality.

Added cost: \$36,525.45

2. Stainless steel angles installed at Verticel to allow for reducing operation of Verticel to one (1) of two (2) trains constructed. Cost of material only.

Added cost: \$19,159.68

The revised contract amount is \$34,525,789.08. The total of all change orders, including Change Order No. 7, is 3.1 % of the original contract amount.

Mr. David Handley presented "Ace", a male mixed birddog, available for adoption at the Enid Animal Shelter.

Proclamations were read and presented proclaiming April 2, 2013 as "Vance Air Force Base Day," April 9, 2013 as "Mayors Day of National Service," and the month of April 2013 as "Civitan Club Awareness Month."

A brief video presentation entitled "Your Town. Your Television," was presented by Ms. Wendy Quarles, Executive Director of PEGASYS, Inc.

Comments were made by City Manager Eric Benson who stated that PEGASYS, currently located in the Cherokee Strip Conference Center, was facing a challenge created by the future elimination of the Center. He stated that a potential new home had been identified in the Non-Profit Center, located at 114 South Independence, and stated that the City had, by contractual obligation, the requirement to provide for the expenses associated with the move. He went on to say that commissioners would be given the opportunity in the next budget year, to identify funding for the relocation, which was estimated at \$399,630.00.

Comments were received from Ms. Cheri Ezzell, Executive Director of the Community Development Support Association, who spoke regarding plans to relocate PEGASYS in the Non-Profit Center.

A hearing was conducted regarding a request to modify the Land Use Map of the Enid Metropolitan Area Comprehensive Plan 2025, from Agriculture Designation to High Intensity Industrial Designation for property described as Lots 1 and 2 and the South Half of the Northeast Quarter, and Lots 3-5 and the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 6, Township 22 North, Range 5 West of the Indian Meridian, and all of the Southeast Quarter of Section 6, Township 22 North, Range 5 West, lying north and east of the railroad right-of-way in said Quarter, located at 2301 North 66th Street, for a proposed canola plant. It was noted that the Area Planning Commission, at its meeting of March 18, 2013, recommended approval of the land use amendment.

Planning Administrator Chris Bauer spoke regarding the land use change, stating that the proposed amendment was consistent with the overall Plan and allowed expansion of the existing high intensity industrial land use classification located south of Willow Road along 54th Street. He stated to support the land use amendment, the following infrastructure improvements were required: 1) 66th Street would be improved from Highway 412 to Willow Road; 2) A new water line would extend east of 54th Street along Chestnut Avenue to 66th Street, north to Willow, and west to the existing water line at Pioneer School, which would complete a loop to the existing water system; and 3) A new sewer line would extend from the plant routed south, to intercept the existing sewer south to the existing lift station. He added that funding for all of the improvements would be provided by tax increment financing.

No comments were received.

A hearing was held regarding a request to rezone property described as Lots 1 and 2 and the South Half of the Northeast Quarter, and Lots 3-5 and the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of

Section 6, Township 22 North, Range 5 West of the Indian Meridian, and all of the Southeast Quarter of Section 6, Township 22 North, Range 5 West, lying north and east of the railroad right-of-way in said Quarter, from "A" Agriculture District to "I-3" Heavy Industrial District, located at 2301 North 66th Street, for a proposed canola plant. It was noted that the Metropolitan Area Planning Commission, at its meeting of March 18, 2013, recommended approval of said rezoning.

No comments were received.

A hearing was held regarding an appeal filed by Central Christian Church regarding the denial of a Certificate of Appropriateness by the Historic Preservation Commission, to demolish a residence at 1115 West Maine, located in the Waverley Historic District.

Comments were made by Mr. Bauer regarding the appeal. He stated that an application for a Certificate of Appropriateness to demolish the residence was presented to the Historic Preservation Commission on April 5, 2012, at which time the item was tabled to allow the Church to develop an alternative to demolition. The Certificate of Appropriateness was reviewed again by the Historic Preservation Commission on September 6, 2012, with no alternatives being offered. A hearing was then held, with the Certificate of Appropriateness denied based on the following five (5) criteria, and demolition of the residence was postponed for 180 days:

- 1. The purpose and intent of this article.
 - The Historic Preservation Commission determined the purpose and intent of the article was to conserve structures in the historic district;
- 2. The degree to which the proposed removal of the historic resources would serve to destroy the integrity and continuity of the historic preservation district of which it is a part.
 - The structure is located on the north edge of the Waverley Historic District and removal would serve to destroy the integrity and continuity of the historic district by five percent (5%);
- 3. The nature of the resource as a representative type or style of architecture, socioeconomic development, historic association or other element of the original designation criteria applicable to such structure or site.

The structure is a contributing architectural style to the Waverley Historic District, which is a bungalow/craftsman architectural style;

4. The condition of the resource from the standpoint of structural integrity and the extent of work necessary to stabilize the structure.

The Historic Preservation Commission determined the exterior could be repaired;

5. Allowing the Church time to develop alternate uses for the property or possibly sell the property.

It was noted that a second hearing was held before the Historic Preservation Commission on

March 7, 2013. The Certificate of Appropriateness was again denied, based on the criteria above, and on

March 12, 2013, the Church appealed the decision to the Mayor and Board of Commissioners for an

additional hearing.

order.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of The City of Enid, Oklahoma, desire to place this judgment on the county judgment rolls and have the payment of said judgment be made in full on April 16, 2013; and,

WHEREAS, The Enid Municipal Authority (EMA), a Public Trust, is willing to purchase and accept assignment of the judgment, and it understands that payment of the judgment will be made from the EMA, through the collection of ad valorem taxes.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants of the parties, the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the City of Enid and the Enid Municipal Authority, hereby covenant and agree:

1. That by virtue of assignment by Michael D. Schatz of his judgment to the EMA, it is entitled to payment of the judgment in the sum of Twenty Seven Thousand Four Hundred Fifty-Five Dollars (\$27,455.00), with interest accruing at the

- applicable Oklahoma statutory judgment rate on the unpaid balance.
- 2. That the EMA accepts assignment of this judgment and payment according to tax levy as cited herein.
- 3. That the dates for payment of the judgment from tax levy proceeds by the Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the City of Enid, Oklahoma is as follows:
 - A. Payment on June 15, 2013, of one-third (1/3) of the principal amount together with statutory interest, if any, accrued to date;
 - B. Payment on June 15, 2014, of one-third (1/3) of the principal amount with statutory interest, if any, accrued since first payment;
 - C. Payment on June 15, 2015, of the balance of the principal and statutory interest due, if any.
- 4. That the parties understand that the amount of the interim annual payments may vary according to tax collections by Garfield County and allocation and receipt thereof by Enid and that payment shall be applied first to interest, then to principal.




