8.1 CONSIDER AWARDING A CONTRACT TO DOWNEY CONSTRUCTION, OKLAHOMA CITY, OKLAHOMA, FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE 211 W. CHESTNUT DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT, PROJECT NO. F-1205A, AND AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE ALL CONTRACT DOCUMENTS AFTER REVIEW BY THE CITY ATTORNEY.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: This project advances the City's goal of eliminating structural flooding, specifically at W. B. Johnston Grain Company, located on West Chestnut Avenue between Van Buren Street and Washington Street, which experiences flooding during high rainfall.

A portion of the contributing drainage area consists of the Burlington Northern Santa Fe's (BNSF) yard. BNSF has agreed to participate in this project with a 50 percent cost share, not to exceed \$150,000.00. The project will install approximately 700 feet of storm water pipe on the public right-of-way.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: This project will replace roof sub-layer materials and repair portions of the substructure of the Santa Fe Depot, while maintaining the buildings architectural design and ceramic tiles.

The project removes the existing tile roof, replaces the sub-tile water proofing, repairs the substructure as required, thence replacing the ceramic tiles. Additionally, the center flat roof area will be replaced with a water proof membrane and the interior ceiling damage will be repaired.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: Convergence Design has completed the design and construction over-sight on the Enid Event Center. As part of their final inspection process, they identified two (2) design corrections for safety improvement, which include modification of hand railing for gate operations and elimination of exposed steel edging.

Key Construction has completed these modifications and Convergence Design has agreed to reduce their compensation for professional services by \$5,518.00.

9.3 APPROVE CHANGE ORDER NO. 1 WITH GOINS ENTERPRISE, INC., JOPLIN, MISSOURI, ON THE 2013 WATER METER MAINTENANCE PROGRAM, PROJECT NO. W-1407A.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: On November 5, 2013, the Commission awarded a bid for Water Maintenance Repairs to Goins Enterprise, Inc. in the amount of \$67,200.00. The bid addressed 16 water meter repairs. Currently, they have completed 38 water meter repairs with \$7,516.10 remaining for use in this project.

Change Order No. 1 would increase the contract by \$9,770.00 for additional repairs. The total amount of the project will be \$76,970.00.

9.4 AWARD CONTRACTS TO MANNING MOWING, ENID, OKLAHOMA, AND GIRLS GETTER DONE, ENID, OKLAHOMA, FOR THE 2014 ABATEMENT PROGRAM.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: The City's abatement program relies on private contractors address high grass and weeds, and trash/debris accumulation for property owners who are unable or unwilling to correct these concerns. The City annually awards contracts for such work. Contractors are selected based on qualifications and price bid per lot to perform the required services. A minimum of two (2) contractors are required to adequately meet the City's abatement program's needs.

The City received bids from two (2) contractors: Manning Mowing and Girls Getter Done. Manning Mowing will be awarded a contract based on a per lot bid of \$75.00 for lots equal to or less than 1/4 acre in size and a per lot bid of \$175.00 for lots more than a 1/4 acre to 1/2 acre in size. Girls Getter Done will be awarded a contract based on a per lot bid of \$85.00 for lots equal to or less than 1/4 acre in size and a per lot bid of \$185.00 for lots more than a 1/4 acre to 1/2 acre in size.

BACKGROUND: This project will provide asphalt resurfacing of the following streets:

 East Broadway from the Burlington Northern Railroad to 16th Street.

- Van Buren Street from 500 feet north of Oxford Avenue to Purdue Avenue.
- Oxford Avenue from Washington Street to 4th Street.
- Washington Street from Willow Road to U.S. Highway 81 (Alternate No.1).

One (1) bid was received from Cummins Construction Company. The base bid was \$1,230,379.45 with three (3) Alternate bids included for additional services.

Contract completion is November 1, 2014. Due to budget constraints Alternate No. 1 will not be awarded.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: The City of Enid has been and remains a leader in re-use of treated wastewater. However, changes in discharge permits for local industries have limited the expansion of this capability.

Amendment No.1 revises the original scope to focus on current needs, which includes assisting the City in acquiring a Re-use Permit from the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality, and conduct a Technical Evaluation of the current treatment process to reduce phosphorus. These actions directly support Koch Nitrogen's plans to utilize re-use water during a pilot program this spring.

This revision adds \$17,275.00 for a revised contract amount of \$92,275.00.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: This project will supply 750 thousand gallons of above ground water storage and a booster pump station in Meadowlake Park. It provides additional intermediate storage capacity and improves service pressure and fire flows to the southern area of Enid.

Change Order No. 2 deducts \$3,313.00 from the contract of final quantities for a revised contract amount of \$2,408,687.00.

Change Order No. 1 added 2,400 linear feet to extend the line to the Meadowlake Park elevated water storage tank.

Change Order No. 2 will add \$13,893.05, to adjust actual quantities delivered for a final revised contract of \$2,082,420.35.

The project was accepted on December 3, 2013 and includes a 3-year Maintenance Bond.

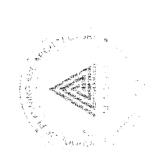

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT

This Economic Development Agreement ("Agreement") is made between and among the Enid Economic Development Authority, an Oklahoma Public Trust ("EEDA"), the City of Enid, Oklahoma, an Oklahoma Municipal Corporation (the "City") and 333 Enid Travel Plaza, LLC, an Oklahoma Limited Liability Company (the "Company").

RECITALS

- **WHEREAS**, there is an increase in East side development and a steep increase in traffic that passes through Enid on Highway 412; and,
- **WHEREAS**, because most trucking companies have pre-negotiated fueling contracts, their drivers are fueling, eating, showering, buying groceries and electronics and conducting business at "branded" travel plazas, such as Pilot, Flying J's, Love's and Petro; and,
- **WHEREAS**, because Enid's only 24-hour truck stop is on Highway 81, there is leakage of unknown amounts of sales and sales tax going to those branded travel plazas outside of the City of Enid; and,
- **WHEREAS**, the truck stop on the East side of Enid on Highway 412 in the City of Enid has operated periodically over the past few decades, but has not been operated for several years; and,
- **WHEREAS**, the company's members are experienced in travel plaza development, one (1) of its newest travel plazas already bringing in well over Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) in sales annually; and,
- **WHEREAS**, the Company intends to become an active member of the Enid business community, expecting to hire at least twenty-five (25) employees, with a payroll in excess of Three Hundred Thousand (\$300,000.00) per year, but needs assistance with initial cash flow (the "Project"); and,
- **WHEREAS**, this Agreement is being entered into with the understanding that the Project proposed to be undertaken and/or facilitated by the Company is anticipated to generate substantial new sales tax revenues for the City of Enid, as well as enhance the overall aesthetics and appeal of the Property; and,
- **WHEREAS**, within and subject to the constraints of applicable state law, the EEDA represents that, in the event the Company undertakes the Project, the EEDA will make to the Company those incentives payments specifically set forth herein; and,
- **WHEREAS**, the EEDA's sources for funding such incentives will be from the increases in those certain sales tax revenues hereinafter described, as such taxes are collected by the City from businesses or operations situated on the Property and transferred to the EEDA; and,

WHEREAS, parties acknowledge that the City cannot legally obligate itself to appropriate or otherwise allocate any future City sales tax or other monies to the EEDA in any fiscal year other than on a year-to-year basis; and,

WHEREAS, the parties acknowledge that the City, within and subject to the annual appropriation requirements of applicable state law, has agreed to provide the funding required by this Agreement, and to take such additional actions as may be reasonably necessary to accommodate and facilitate the EEDA's performance of this Agreement; and,

WHEREAS, based on the foregoing, the Company has agreed to move forward and complete the Project; and,

WHEREAS, in connection with the development of the Project, the parties desire to more specifically outline the scope, projected cost, time-line and project coordination associated with the completion of the Project.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises, covenants, and conditions herein stated, and in consideration of the mutual benefits, which will accrue to the parties, the receipt and sufficiency of which is acknowledged by the parties, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. <u>Definitions</u>. The following words, terms and phrases, when used in this Agreement, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this section.
 - a. Incentive Calculation The incentive will be calculated as follows: Net taxable sales multiplied by the Incentive Rate.
 - b. Incentive Expiration Date The date which is four (4) years after the Incentive Start Date or the date upon which the Company has received a total of One Hundred Two Thousand One Hundred and Twelve Dollars (\$102,112.00), whichever occurs earlier.
 - c. Incentive Rate The Incentive Rate for this Agreement is one percent (1%).
 - d. Incentive Start Date The date upon which the City begins receiving sales tax revenues from the Project.
- 2. <u>Commencement of the Project</u>. The Company shall commence the Project as soon as practicable after the mutual execution of this Agreement. The Project shall include a a 24-hour Travel Plaza at 102 S. 42nd Street, along Highway 412. The Travel Plaza shall include at least one (1) restaurant. Should the company fail to have the Travel Plaza open and operating by December 31, 2014, this Agreement shall immediately become null and void.

- 3. <u>Incentives</u>. To assist the Company in completing the Project, the EEDA will provide the Company with a bi-annual economic development Incentive.
- 4. Payment of Incentives. Bi-annually, after the Incentive Start Date, the Company will share appropriate financials showing the sales subject to City sales tax from the Project with the Enid Regional Development Alliance (ERDA). The ERDA will calculate the Incentive earned and submit an invoice to the City. The City or the EEDA shall review and process the invoice and pay the Incentive to the Company. Payments shall cease on the Incentive Expiration Date.
- 5. <u>Termination</u>. The Company shall have the right to terminate this Agreement upon thirty (30) days notice to the other parties hereto.
- 6. <u>Default</u>. Under this Agreement, default occurs when either party fails to keep, observe, or perform any material agreement, term, or provision of this Agreement to be kept, observed, or performed by it and such conduct continues for a period of thirty (30) days after written notice thereof by the other party.
- Remedies. In the event of any default in or breach of any terms or conditions of this Agreement by any party, or any successor, the defaulting or breaching party shall, upon written notice from the other party, proceed immediately to cure or remedy such default or breach, and shall in any event, within thirty (30) days after receipt of notice, commence to cure or remedy such default. In case such cure or remedy is not taken or not diligently pursued, or the default or breach shall not be cured or remedied within a reasonable time, the aggrieved party may institute such proceedings as may be necessary or desirable, in its opinion, to cure and remedy such default or breach, including, but not limited to, proceedings to compel specific performance by the defaulting or breaching party.
- 8. <u>Interpretation and Choice of Law.</u> This Agreement shall be deemed to have been made in the State of Oklahoma and shall be construed and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Oklahoma. Any action or proceeding seeking to enforce any provision of, or based on any right arising out of, this Agreement may be brought against any of the parties in the courts of the State of Oklahoma, County of Garfield, or, if it has or can acquire jurisdiction, in the United States District Court for the Western District of Oklahoma, and each of the parties consents to the jurisdiction of such courts (and of the appropriate appellate courts) in any such action or proceeding and waives any objection to venue laid therein
- 9. <u>Counterparts</u>. This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, and when each party has signed and delivered to the other at least one (1) such counterpart, each counterpart shall be deemed an original, and when taken together with other signed counterparts, shall constitute one (1) agreement; provided, however, this Agreement shall not be binding upon the parties hereto until signed by both parties.

- 10. Entire Agreement. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and may not be amended, altered, modified or changed in any way except in writing signed by all parties to this Agreement and which specifically references this Contract. There are no other agreements, representations or warranties, whether oral or written, regarding the subject matter of this Agreement. No course of dealings involving the parties hereto and no usage of trade shall be relevant or admissible to interpret, supplement, explain or in any way vary any of the terms expressly set forth in this Agreement. Any amendment to this Agreement shall be attached hereto and all of the terms in this Agreement not addressed in the amendment shall remain in full force and effect.
- 11. <u>Severability</u>. In the event that any term or provision or this Agreement is held to be unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder shall continue in full force and effect to the extent the remainder can be given effect without the invalid provision.
- 12. <u>Assignment</u>. Neither party shall assign this Agreement, or any interest herein, without the express, written consent of the other party, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld; provided, however, this Agreement shall be permitted to be assigned, upon written notice by the Company, to a Lender to the Company, as collateral on a loan for the Project.
- 13. <u>Binding Effect.</u> This Agreement shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective successors and assigns. In the event of the transfer of the Property, the assignee shall be entitled to succeed to the full rights and benefits, as well as obligations, of this Agreement.
- 14. <u>Non-Discrimination</u>. The parties covenant (1) that no person shall be excluded from participation in, denied the benefit of, or otherwise subjected to discrimination under the terms of this Agreement on the ground of race, color, age, sex, handicap, or national origin; and (2) that, in carrying out the terms and conditions of this Agreement, no person shall be subjected to discrimination on the grounds of race, color, age, sex, handicap, or national origin.
- 15. Authority. This Agreement shall become a binding obligation upon execution by all parties hereto. The EEDA warrants and represents that the individual executing this Agreement on behalf of the EEDA has full authority to execute this Agreement and bind the EEDA to the same. The EEDA further warrants and represents that this Agreement is valid and enforceable under applicable law and the EEDA has taken all requisite action necessary to approve this Agreement. The Company warrants and represents that the individual executing this Agreement on its behalf has full authority to execute this Agreement and bind the Company to the same. The Company further warrants and represents that this Agreement is valid and enforceable under applicable law and the Company's corporate documents, and that the Company has taken all requisite action necessary to approve this Agreement.

- 16. <u>Compliance with Laws</u>. The Company shall conduct its business under the terms of this Agreement in such a manner that it does not violate federal, state, or local laws or regulations applicable to the conduct of its operations under the terms of this Agreement.
- 17. <u>Third Party Beneficiaries</u>. Nothing in this Agreement, expressed or implied, is intended to confer upon any person other than the parties hereto and their respective assigns, any rights or remedies under or by reason of this Agreement, except as provided expressly herein.
- 18. <u>Indemnification and Hold Harmless</u>. The Company shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless the EEDA and the City and any and all officers, agents and employees of the EEDA and the City, against all damages, including but not limited to, any loss, liability, expense, suit, or claim for injury to persons or damages to property arising out of the activities of the Company, its employees and agents under or in connection with this Agreement, whether or not any act or omission complained of is authorized, allowed or prohibited by the Company and all reasonable expenses together with all damages and penalties thereto. Expenses shall include, without limitation, all out-of-pocket expenses, attorney's fees, witness fees, and discovery costs.
- 19. <u>Notices</u>. Any notice, request or demand provided for in this Agreement shall be deemed to have been sent when the notice has been delivered by personal delivery, overnight mail or delivery service, facsimile or deposited in the United States mail, registered or certified, with postage thereon prepaid to the addresses as set forth below:

- 20. <u>Bargaining</u>. The City, the EEDA and the Company have had the opportunity to seek independent legal counsel before entering into this Agreement. The City, the EEDA and the Company have participated fully in the preparation of this Agreement and the language of this Agreement shall be construed simply, according to its fair meaning, and not strictly for or against any party.
- 21. <u>Construction</u>. Captions and other headings contained in this Agreement are for reference and identification purposes only and do not alter, modify, amend, limit, or restrict the contractual obligations of the parties.
- 22. <u>Year-to-Year Agreement</u>. Notwithstanding any provision contained herein, the parties hereto expressly declare their intention that the covenants of the City regarding the transfer of excess sales tax revenues to the EEDA shall not constitute a debt or obligation of the City in violation of Article X, Section 26 of the Oklahoma Constitution, but that the payments being made to the Company shall be payable hereunder only to the extent that funds are appropriated by the governing body of the City in any given fiscal year.
- 23. Governmental Tort Claims Act. By entering into this Agreement, City, and "employees" of the City, as defined by the Governmental Tort Claims Act, 51 Okla. Stat. § 151 et seq., do not waive sovereign immunity, any defenses, or any limitations of liability as may be provided for by law. No provision of this Agreement modifies and/or waives any provision of the Local Government Tort Claims Act.

NEW MARKET TAX CREDITS CONSULTING AGREEMENT

This New Market Tax Credits Consulting Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into as of March 4, 2014 by and between, the City of Enid, an Oklahoma Municipal Corporation the ("Client") with its principal executive offices located at 401 W Owen K. Garriott RD, Enid, OK 73701 and HARRISON, WALKER & HARPER GROUP, LLC ("HWH"), a Texas limited liability Company located at 2510 South Church Street, Paris, Texas 75460.

RECITALS

- A. Client has requested HWH to provide consulting services related to the structuring, monetizing and closing of a transaction utilizing the New Market Tax Credit Program "NMTC". Such services will be provided as they relate to Client's establishment of a NMTC transaction which is described as a Parking Garage with retail space in Enid, Oklahoma. ("Project").
- B. HWH is willing to provide such consulting services according to the terms and conditions set forth herein;
- C. Client appoints HWH as its agent for the specific purpose of providing consulting services as specified in (A.) above as it relates to the Client's establishment of new facilities and business expansions and grants to HWH the exclusive right to provide those certain services outlined below, with respect to the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises, covenants, and conditions contained in this Agreement, the parties agree as follows:

TERM: The term of this Agreement begins on the date first indicated above and will continue for twenty-four (24) consecutive months. HWH understands that this Agreement is subject to budget appropriation by the City and approval by the City of Enid Board of Commissioners. If the Board of Commissioners does not approve this Agreement, or sufficient funds are not appropriated or allocated for payment under this Agreement for any current or future fiscal period, then City, at its option, may terminate this Agreement on the last day of any calendar month without future obligations, liabilities or penalties to HWH except for amounts due up to the time of termination for the services performed to date.

2) HWH PROVIDED SERVICES:

2.1 HWH will provide NMTC program consulting services for the Project. Throughout the process, HWH will work with Client's technical operations, legal, tax, public relations and other professionals as directed by Client. The consulting services expected to be provided for the project are:

- (i) "Phase I", Feasibility Analysis, wherein characteristics and data applicable to the Project are analyzed and an assessment is made as to whether the Project meets requirements of the NMTC program. Materials to be provided by Client as they relate to the project include but are not limited to (1) project data addressing typical NMTC application data points (2) historical financial statements and 7 year forecasts for any associated operating or real estate companies and (3) evidence of all Non NMTC source of funds availability such as letters of intent, term sheets or proposals from all applicable lenders or fund sources;
- (ii) "Phase II", Initial structuring analysis shall be undertaken and potential suitable NMTC structures are presented to Client for review and approval.
- (iii) "Phase III", Underwriting package assembled and the search process is initiated for suitable and compatible Community Development Entities ("CDE's)"; Analysis and determination of suitable and compatible CDE is completed.
- (iv) "Phase IV", Coordination of underwriting process between CDE and Client is undertaken. Upon approval from CDE, NMTC term sheet and/or reservation of credits letter is sought and executed by Client and CDE.
- (v) "Phase V", Implementation/Documentation, wherein communications are finalized with all applicable parties to execute suitable NMTC structures. CLIENT approved NMTC structure is finalized into fully executed agreements and documentation and NMTC transaction is closed and funded.
- 2.2 <u>Client Cooperation.</u> During the term hereof, Client agrees to cooperate with HWH to the extent reasonably necessary to complete services detailed in 2.1 above. In this regard, Client agrees to assign a senior person to coordinate this engagement ("<u>Engagement Coordinator</u>"), as well as assign appropriate staff to work with the Engagement Coordinator and HWH.
- 2.3 <u>Client Authority.</u> Notwithstanding anything contained herein to the contrary, Client acknowledges and agrees that HWH's services may include advice, opinions or recommendations as to which benefits or tax credits may be obtained, but all decisions in connection with the implementation of any such advice, opinions or recommendations shall in fact be made by, and are the responsibility of, Client. Client shall have the sole authority and sole discretion to elect and approve the structures of all State, Local and Federal incentive programs including the NMTC transaction as it applies to the Client's establishment of new facilities and business expansions.
- 2.4 <u>Exclusive Contact</u>. Client acknowledges that the services shall be more effective if such services are directed through a single point of contact. Therefore, related to the Project, Client agrees to direct all communications and materials associated with the Project exclusively through HWH.
- 3) <u>PERSONNEL</u>: It is understood and agreed that HWH shall perform all services hereunder as an independent contractor.
- 4) **FEE:** HWH agrees to provide the services and receive compensation as follows:
 - **4.1** HWH will receive a NMTC Administration and Consulting Fee paid at closing of three per cent (3.0%) of the "Project Value" for the services described in 2.1 above.

As to the NMTC Administration and Consulting Fee and **Project Value**, the parties acknowledge and agree that:

a. Project value shall mean the aggregate of all amounts invested/contributed as equity investments in the Project using a NMTC structure. The NMTC Administration and Consulting Fee shall apply to the Client's establishment of the Project, regardless of the Project sponsor (QALICB) and whether or not the Client received the benefit of the NMTC structure either directly or indirectly. For example, should the Client elect a structure whereas a new entity is formed as the QALICB or Project sponsor, HWH shall remain entitled to the NMTC Administration and Consulting Fee.

- Client is responsible for all Community Development Entity "CDE" fees whether paid at closing or due subsequently and shall be paid without any reduction in the NMTC Administration and Consulting Fee calculation hereunder;

Legal counsel fees related to the structuring, monetizing and closing of the NMTC transaction resulting from legal counsel engaged or required by the Client, CDEs or NMTC Investors will be the responsibility of the Client and will be paid by Client at closing. The cost of legal counsel and other consultants retained and approved by Client shall be at the sole expense of Client without any reduction in the NMTC Administration and Consulting Fee calculation hereunder;
- d. Brokerage fees specifically related to the structuring, monetizing and closing of the NMTC and previously approved by HWH and the Client will be the responsibility of the Client and paid by the Client at closing.
- e. Notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, during the twelve (12) month period following the expiration of this Agreement and any renewals thereof, HWH shall be entitled to its entire NMTC Administration and Consulting Fee if Client closes a NMTC transaction concerning the Project utilizing the same CDE or substantially the same NMTC structure as developed or provided by HWH.
- 5) **RETAINER FEE**: HWH will waive its standard retainer for this project.
- 6) NOTICE AND DISCLAIMER: HWH makes no warranties or representations regarding any Incentives which may be obtained. Client acknowledges that there exists strong competition for an allocation of NMTCs and HWH cannot guarantee that a placement of NMTCs for Client's project will be made. Notwithstanding the form (e.g. contract, negligence or otherwise) in which any legal or equitable action may be brought against HWH, HWH shall not be liable to Client for damages which exceed the amount of all fees paid or payable to HWH under this Agreement. Further, HWH shall not be liable for any damages or loss (including damages for loss of business, loss of profits, or the like) in excess of the fees actually paid to and received by HWH, whether based on breach of contract, tort (including negligence), product liability or otherwise, even if HWH or its representatives have been advised of such damages. This provision shall survive termination of this agreement. Nothing contained in this agreement shall be deemed to require or represent that HWH will provide brokerage services or other services regulated by the Securities and Exchange Commission or a State Securities Board. Any required brokerage services will be provided through a contracted third party licensed broker. The statements contained herein are not intended to and do not constitute an opinion as to any tax or other matter. They are not intended or written to be used, and may not be relied upon, by you or any other person for the purpose of avoiding penalties that may be imposed under any Federal tax law or otherwise.
- 7) MISCELLANEOUS: This Agreement is binding upon the parties hereto and their respective successors and assigns. This Agreement may be executed in two or more counterparts, all of which shall be considered one and the same agreement. The individuals signing this Agreement represent that they are authorized signatories. The terms and conditions of this Agreement which by their sense and context are intended to survive the completion of performance and/or termination of this Agreement will do so. The provisions of this Agreement shall be deemed severable, and if any part of any provision is held illegal, void or invalid under applicable law, such

provision may be changed to the extent reasonably necessary to make the provision, as so changed, legal, valid and binding. If any provision of this Agreement is held illegal, void or invalid in its entirety, the remaining provisions of this Agreement shall not in any way be affected or impaired but shall remain binding in accordance with their terms. If either party institutes legal action to enforce its rights under this Agreement, the prevailing party will be entitled to recover its reasonable attorneys' fees and other costs so incurred. This agreement is entered into and is performable in Garfield County, Oklahoma. Any action or proceeding arising out of this Agreement may be brought against either of the parties in the Garfield County District Court, or, if it has or can acquire jurisdiction, in the United States District Court for the Western District of Oklahoma, and each of the parties consents to the jurisdiction of such courts (and of the appropriate appellate courts) in any such action or proceeding and waives any objection to venue laid therein.
