8.2 CONSIDER A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO LEVY AGAINST THE TAX ROLLS A JUDGMENT OF THE WORKERS' COMPENSATION COURT OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA, ENTERED IN FAVOR OF RICHARD L. WALLACE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$36,000.00; APPROVING AN AGREEMENT ACKNOWLEDGING SUCH JUDGMENT, PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF SUCH JUDGMENT IN EXCHANGE FOR THE CITY'S PROMISE TO REPAY SUCH JUDGMENT FROM COLLECTED TAX LEVIES.

BACKGROUND: This is a companion to item 12.2. Richard L. Wallace is a Heavy Equipment Operator for the City of Enid. On February 27, 2013, he injured his right arm when he slipped while entering a bull dozer. He hung from his right arm, fracturing the end of the humorous bone, which subsequently resulted in surgery on his shoulder. The City admitted injuries to Mr. Wallace's arm. A settlement was approved by

the Worker's Compensation Court on October 22, 2014, and Mr. Wallace was awarded \$36,000.00.00. This item levies the judgment.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: This project will provide repair of streets, sidewalks, drives, curbs, and gutters after concrete is excavated for water line repairs. This project funds labor only for concrete repairs, the City of Enid will provide all required materials.

Derwin's Construction submitted the sole bid for this project with the following detailed items:

9.4 APPROVE LETTER OF AGREEMENT FOR STORMWATER DEVELOPMENT FEE CREDITS WITH WORLD HARVEST CHURCH, ENID, OKLAHOMA, RESULTING FROM IMPROVEMENTS TO OAKWOOD WEST DETENTION FACILITY.

BACKGROUND: The developer for the World Harvest Church, on South Garland Road between W. Owen K. Garriott Road and Rupe Avenue, has removed 7,500 cubic yards of soil from the Oakwood West Detention facility site. City Ordinance allows a developer to receive credits for improvements made to Master Drainage Plan projects to the level of the savings provided to the City by the improvement. The removal of 7,500 cubic yards of soil equates to \$31,875.00 of improvements, which can be used to off-set stormwater development impact fees. An amount of \$8,566.15 of the credits will be used to off-set World Harvest Church's site storm water development fee, and the remaining \$23,308.85 of credits will be available to off-set future stormwater development impact fees in the same basin. The advantage to the public of this agreement is that approximately 30% of the Oakwood West Detention Facility excavation will be provided with no direct cost to the public.

Discussion was held regarding a final plat for Stonebridge First Addition, Blocks 1 and 2.

Planning Administrator explained that the plat was the first phase of the residential portion of the Stonebridge Planned Unit Development (PUD), and contained 24 lots for single-family residences. He noted that the Metropolitan Area Planning Commission recommended approval of the Final Plat at its October 20, 2014 meeting, contingent upon sidewalks being installed the width of the subdivision along the north side of Chestnut Avenue.

Commissioner Timm asked if the plat could be changed to require sidewalks in front of the residential homes.

Mr. Bauer responded, stating that City Attorney Andrea Chism had advised staff that because this was a PUD, commissioners could negotiate with the developer to make sidewalks a requirement.

Commissioner Vanhooser moved to approve the Final Plat for Stonebridge First Addition, Blocks One and Two, with the requirement that sidewalks be placed on the north side of Chestnut Avenue, as recommended by the Metropolitan Area Planning Commission, and to require interior sidewalks within the residential portion of the PUD.

Mr. Brent Kisling, Executive Director of the Enid Regional Development Alliance, explained that Love's was currently under contract to purchase approximately 100 acres of land located near the intersection of U.S. Highway 412 and North 42nd Street to develop a full-service Love's travel stop facility with attendant businesses and hotel. He stated that it was necessary to extend both water and sewer to the site and provide infrastructure for future developments nearby. To expedite the process, Love's agreed to construct the work and advance the funds necessary to pay for the improvements. In return, the Enid Economic Development Authority would reimburse Love's for the City's portion of the project in an amount not to exceed the lesser of sixty-five percent (65%) of the cost, or \$592,410.00, which would be funded by a refund of City sales taxes generated from the travel stop and hotel, with payments to be made quarterly to Love's over a seven (7) year reimbursement period.

Mr. Alex Fuller, representative of the real estate division for Love's Travel Stops and Country Stores, Inc. addressed the Commission. He spoke regarding the project, and answered questions and concerns posed by the Commission.

Following brief discussion, motion was made by Commissioner Ezzell and seconded by Commissioner Brownlee to approve said agreement as presented, and the vote was as follows:

ORDINANCE NO. 2014-___

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ENID MUNICIPAL CODE, 2014, TITLE 9, ENTITLED "BUILDING REGULATIONS," CHAPTER 4, ENTITLED "ELECTRICAL CODE," SECTION 9-4-3, ENTITLED "AMENDMENTS TO ELECTRICAL CODE" TO AMEND THE QUALIFICATIONS FOR ELECTRICAL INSPECTOR AND CORRECT GRAMMATICAL ERRORS; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER, SAVINGS CLAUSE, SEVERABILITY AND CODIFICATION.

<u>Section I</u>: That Title 9, Chapter 4, Section 9-4-3 of the Enid Municipal Code, 2014, is hereby to read as follows:

9-4-3: AMENDMENTS TO ELECTRICAL CODE:

Article 90 Introduction is hereby amended in the following respects:

90.9 is hereby created to read as follows: All public utilities engaged in the furnishing of electricity, operating under a franchise with the Ceity of Enid, shall be exempt from compliance with this chapter insofar as the same affects property owned or controlled by such utility.

Article 100 Definitions is hereby amended in the following respects:

Insert: Electrical Contractor Or Employing Electrician: Any person engaged in the business of wiring, rewiring, installing, repairing or altering any electrical wiring, or installing or repairing any electrical apparatus, electrical appliances, or electrical equipment.

Insert: Electrical Dealer: Any person engaged in the business of selling or offering for sale electrical materials, devices, apparatus and electrical apparatus and electrical appliances that are not installed by such persons.

Insert: Electrical Equipment: Any electrical wires, appliances, apparatus or electrical construction of any kind whatsoever, installed in or used in or about any building or other structure in the Ceity.

Insert: Electrical Work: Any construction, installation, maintenance or repair of electrical conductors and equipment installed within or on private and public buildings and other premises, including yards, carnival and parking lots, industrial substations, and the conductors that connect the installations to a supply of electricity, and other outside conductors adjacent to the premises; also mobile homes and travel trailers.

Insert: Electrician's Apprentice: A person other than a master or journeyman electrician, who, as his principal occupation, is engaged in learning and assisting in electrical wiring and electrical work, but must be in the company of a licensed master electrician or electrical contractor and must work under the immediate supervision and direction of and in the presence of a master or journeyman electrician.

Insert: Journeyman Electrician: Any person in the employ of an electrical contractor or employing contractor, actually engaged in the work of wiring, rewiring, installing, repairing or altering any electrical wiring, or installing or repairing any electrical apparatus or electrical appliances.

Insert: Master Electrician: Any person who has the qualifications of an electrician and is familiar with the construction of electrical wiring and apparatus, and the hazards involved, and who does the actual work himself, or through journeyman electricians; the term includes contracting or employing electrician.

Article 120 Electrical Inspector is hereby created to read as follows:

- 1. Office Created: The office of Eelectrical Inspector is hereby created in the Ccity of Enid.
- 2. Appointment: The Eelectrical Inspector shall be appointed as other appointive officers.
- 31. Qualifications: The minimum qualifications for Eelectrical Inspector are as set forth in Oklahoma Statutes, which is three (3) years of active experience in the electrical industry. In creating job descriptions and open position, the City Manager may require additional qualifications, shall have at least four (4) years' experience as a journeyman electrician in the practice of his trade, or two (2) years' training in a recognized college of mechanical engineering, and an additional three wo (32) years of practical experience in electrical construction.
- 42. Duties: It shall be the duty of the <u>E</u>electrical <u>I</u>inspector to enforce all laws and ordinances relating to the electrical code, to issue permits, and make such inspections as may be required.
- 53. Right Of Entry Fror Inspection: Subject to constitutional limitations, the Inspector or his authorized representative shall have the right to enter any premises for the purpose of inspecting the same, at such time as may be reasonably necessary to protect the public health.

Article 130 Permits <u>aAnd Inspections is hereby created to read as follows:</u>

- 1. Permit Required; Exceptions:
 - a. No electrical work, unless excepted in this section, shall be undertaken prior to issuance of a permit therefore by the **Ee**lectrical **!i**nspector.
 - b. A permit shall not be required for:
 - 1) Minor repair work, such as repairing flush and snap switches, replacing fuses, changing lamp sockets and receptacles, taping bare joints, and replacing drop cords,

- 2) Maintenance and repairs on the premises of a person regularly employing journeymen electricians for that purpose.
- 2. Permit Application, Issuance <u>a</u>And Fee: An electrical permit shall be issued after application has been made therefore, and upon the forms prescribed by the city, showing that the ordinances of the <u>Ceity</u> will be complied with, and upon payment of the fee provided for in <u>tTitle 2</u>, <u>eChapter 6</u>, <u>aArticle F of the Enid <u>Mmunicipal Ceode</u>.</u>
- 3. Inspection <u>aAnd</u> Concealment <u>oOf</u> Certain Wires: All wires which are to be hidden from view shall be inspected before concealment, and the person doing the electrical work shall notify the <u>Eelectrical Iinspector</u> to make the required inspection before such wires are concealed, and shall not conceal the same until permission has been obtained in writing from the <u>Eelectrical Iinspector</u>.
- 4. Inspection Fee: A fee as provided in <u>*Title 2</u>, <u>eChapter 6</u>, <u>aArticle F of the Enid Mmunicipal Ceode shall be paid to the <u>dDirector of <u>*Finance for each electrical inspection to be made.</u></u></u>
- 5. Certificate Of Inspection Or Service Permit: Upon the completion of wiring in any building, structure or place, the licensee installing the same shall notify the Electrical Inspector, who shall cause the installation to be inspected, and, if found to be in compliance with this chapter, shall issue a certificate of inspection, or service permit, authorizing connection to the electrical circuit, and the energizing of the installation. No such connection or energizing shall be made until such a certificate or service permit is issued.
- 6. Triple Fees Authorized: All fees are tripled if work is started prior to the issuance of any permit. Existing equipment change outs shall be permitted to start prior to inspection and issuance of permit. The assessment and/or payment of triple fees shall in no way prevent further penalty, such as suspension or revocation of a license and/or permit for excessive repetition of violations.

Article 140 Electricians is hereby created to read as follows:

- 1. State License Required: Any electrical contractor, journeyman electrician or apprentice electrician who performs work in the <u>eCity</u> is required to have an <u>state-Oklahoma</u> license.
- 2. Registration Required; Marking Oof Vehicles:
 - a. No person, as principal, agent, manager, or employee, shall conduct, manage or carry on the trade, calling or business of an electrical contractor, or do any electrical work of any kind or description in the Ceity, for which an electrical permit is required, without registering with the Ceity Celerk and securing a registration from the Ceity. The Ceity Celerk shall issue such registration upon presentation of a valid eElectrical eContractor's License issued by the sState of

Oklahoma and upon payment of the required fee and posting of bond, where required.

b. All vehicles used in electrical work shall have signs stating the name of the contractor and the Ceity registration number in letters at least two inches (2") high affixed to both sides of the vehicle.

3. Issuance Oof Registration:

- a. The Ceity Celerk shall issue an electrical contractor's registration upon presentation of the state license², bond where required, and payment of the annual fees as established in <u>*Title 2</u>, <u>eChapter 6</u>, <u>aArticle F of the Enid Memunicipal Ceode.</u>
- b. All registrations shall expire July 31 of the following year after their issuance. Penalty fees shall be charged for late registration as established in <u>*Title 2</u>, <u>eChapter 6</u>, <u>aArticle F of the Enid Mmunicipal Ceode</u>.
- c. All services performed by utility companies operating under franchise agreements, and the employees of such utility companies, are hereby exempt from subsection 3a of this section for work done under the supervision and direction of said utility companies.

4. Revocation OF Registration:

- a. Subsequent to a hearing, conducted as hereinafter provided in this subsection, the <u>Ceonstruction Bboard of Aappeals may recommend the suspension or revocation of an electrical contractor registration issued pursuant to this eCode to the <u>Mmayor and Bboard of Ceommissioners if it has reason to believe or finds that the holder has:</u></u>
 - 1) Made a material misstatement in the application for any registration or renewal thereof;
 - 2) Loaned or illegally used his registration;
 - 3) Violated any provisions of this <u>Ceode</u>; or,
 - 4) Committed any act specified in this Ceode as grounds for suspension and/or revocation of any registration.
- b. Complaints against any person registered under this chapter may be filed with the Bboard by the Oeffice of the Eelectrical Linspector. Such complaint shall be investigated by or before the Bboard. All complaints must be in writing, signed and duly verified by the Oeffice of Eelectrical Linspector. This procedure shall not

be exclusive and shall not preclude the filing of a complaint in the Mmunicipal Ceourt.

- c. The person against whom a complaint is signed shall be entitled to a public hearing before the Board. Within ten (10) days after the filing of a written complaint, the Board shall serve written notice of the complaint upon the registered person. The notice shall be served either personally or by certified mail, return receipt requested. If the notice is served personally, it must be served at least ten (10) days prior to any scheduled hearing. If the notice is served by mail, it must be postmarked at least ten (10) days prior to any scheduled hearing. The notice shall include:
 - 1) A statement of the time, place and nature of the hearing;
 - 2) A statement of the legal authority and jurisdiction under which the hearing is to be held;
 - 3) A reference to the particular sections of the Ceode and rules involved;
 - 4) A copy of the complaint;
 - A statement that the accused has a right to a public hearing in his defense at which time he may respond to the allegations in the complaint by his testimony, the testimony of witnesses, or other admissible evidence;
 - 6) A statement that the individual has a right to be represented by legal counsel and a right to confront his accusers; and,
 - 7) A statement that, based upon the evidence presented at the hearing, the Board shall decide to either dismiss the complaint or recommend suspension or revocation of the registration.
- d. The <u>B</u>board, in its hearing, shall follow the rules of evidence of the state. All writings or documents admitted into evidence shall become part of the record of the proceedings. A party or members of the <u>B</u>board may conduct direct and cross examinations required for a full and true disclosure of the facts. After all evidence has been submitted, the <u>B</u>board shall vote to either dismiss the complaint or recommend to the <u>M</u>mayor and <u>B</u>board of <u>C</u>eommissioners suspension or revocation of the registration. A recommended suspension shall include a recommendation for the period of time during which the registration is to be suspended; provided, however, that a registration cannot be suspended for a period of time exceeding six (6) months. (Ord. 2013-14, 2-21-2013, eff. 4-1-2013)

<u>Section II</u>: Repealer. All ordinances or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with this ordinance, are hereby repealed.

<u>Section III</u>: Savings Clause. Nothing in this ordinance hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceedings now pending in any court, or any rights acquired or liability incurred, nor any cause or causes of action accrued or existing, under any act or ordinance repealed hereby. Nor shall any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this ordinance.

<u>Section IV</u>: Severability. If any one or more of the sections, sentences, clauses or parts of this ordinance, chapter or section shall, for any reason, be held invalid, the invalidity of such section, clause or part shall not affect or prejudice in any way the applicability and validity of any other provision of this ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Commission of the City of Enid that this section of the Enid Municipal Code would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part not been included.

<u>Section V</u>: Codification. This ordinance shall be codified as Title 9, Chapter 4, Section 9-4-3 of the Enid Municipal Code, 2014.

is hereby approved.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ENID MUNICIPAL CODE, 2014, TITLE 10, ENTITLED "PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT," CHAPTER "CAPITAL RECOVERY," **ENTITLED IMPROVEMENT AND** TO SECTION 10-4-3 **IDENTIFY** LOCATION OF **SIDEWALK** REGULATIONS **AND CORRECT** GRAMMATICAL **ERRORS:** CREATING TITLE 10, ENTITLED "CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND RECOVERY," CHAPTER 6, ENTITLED "SIDEWALKS," SECTIONS 10-6-1 AND 10-6-2 TO RELOCATE SIDEWALK REGULATIONS AND EXPAND THE REQUIREMENT TO PROVIDE SIDEWALKS TO ALL DEVELOPMENTS AND REDEVELOPMENTS; AMENDING TITLE 12, ENTITLED "SUBDIVISIONS," CHAPTER 6, ENTITLED "SUBDIVISION DESIGN STANDARDS," SECTION 12-6-2, ENTITLED "STREET," TO RELOCATE **SIDEWALK** REGULATIONS AND CORRECT **GRAMMATICAL ERRORS**; AMENDING TITLE 12, ENTITLED "SUBDIVISIONS," CHAPTER 8, ENTITLED "CONSTRUCTION PLANS AND SPECIFICATION," SECTION 12-8-7, ENTITLED "SIDEWALK PLANS," CONSTRUCTION TO **UPDATE SIDEWALK** SPECIFICATIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH FEDERAL LAWS AND REGULATIONS; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER, SAVINGS CLAUSE, SEVERABILITY, AND CODIFICATION.

ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ENID, OKLAHOMA:

<u>Section I</u>: That Title 10, Chapter 4, Section 10-4-3, of the Enid Municipal Code, 2014, is hereby amended to read as follows:

10-4-3: CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT REQUIREMENTS:

The purpose of this <u>sS</u>ection is to identify capital improvements required to support the efficient and effective growth and development of the <u>eC</u>ity of Enid, limit financial impact on the <u>eC</u>ity of Enid and establish development responsibility to provide capital improvements.

A. Water System:

- 1. New development sites shall extend the public water system across the length of the subdivision or developed site.
- 2. Water system improvements shall comply with section 8-2-14 of this eCode.
- B. Sanitary Sewer System:

- 1. New development sites shall extend the public sanitary sewer system to the site.
- 2. Sanitary sewers shall be constructed to the size requirement specified in the <u>eCity</u> of Enid <u>sSanitary sSewer mMaster pPlan</u>, but not less than the capacity required for development site.

C. Stormwater System:

- 1. New development shall provide improvement of the public stormwater system to transport stormwater through the development site in accordance with <u>tTitle</u> 12, "Subdivisions", of this <u>eCode</u>.
- 2. New development shall mitigate the impact from the development site by improving the downstream drainageways to comply with <u>tT</u>itle 12, "Subdivisions", of this <u>eC</u>ode, or include an improvement plan to mitigate the impact by on site detention or other acceptable means. The mitigation shall cover the impact from the development site to the main drainage channel as defined in the <u>eC</u>ity of Enid <u>sS</u>tormwater <u>mMaster pPlan</u>.

D. Transportation System:

- 1. New development shall provide that public roads within the development must be in compliance with <u>*Title 12</u>, "Subdivisions", of this <u>eC</u>ode.
- 2. Subdivision development on arterial streets shall provide acceleration and decelerations lanes, per <u>*T</u>itle 12 of this <u>eC</u>ode.
- 3. Development, under <u>sSection 11-11-2</u>, <u>"sSite pPlan FReview,"</u> of this <u>eCode</u>, shall provide public infrastructure improvements as required by the site plan process to provide for adequate and safe vehicular access to adjacent streets.

E. Sidewalks:

1. New development and redevelopment shall provide sidewalks in accordance with subsSection 12-6-2Y10-6-1 and sSection 12-8-7 of this eCode.

F. Fire Protection System:

1. New development and redevelopment shall provide fire hydrants in accordance with the <u>iI</u>nternational <u>fF</u>ire <u>eC</u>ode as adopted by the <u>eC</u>ity. (Ord. 2010-14, 12-14-2010)

Section II: That Title 10, Chapter 6, is hereby created to read as follows:

Chapter 6
SIDEWALKS

10-6-1: SIDEWALKS REQUIRED:

- A. All developments and redevelopments must include sidewalks that parallel all abutting streets.
- B. Multifamily residential, commercial, educational, industrial and public gathering developments must incorporate sidewalks within its development.

10-6-2: SIDEWALK SPECIFICATIONS:

- A. Sidewalks shall comply with the most current accessibility guidelines associated with the Americans with Disabilities Act.
- B. Sidewalks shall be constructed using the minimum specifications provided in Section 12-8-7 of this Code.
- C. Should a conflict arise between guidelines associated with the Americans with Disabilities Act and the specifications provided in Section 12-8-7, the more restrictive shall apply.

<u>Section III</u>: That Title 12, Chapter 6, Section 12-6-2, of the Enid Municipal Code, 2014, is hereby amended to read as follows:

12-6-2: STREETS:

- A. Conformity: The arrangement, character, extent, width, grade and location of all streets shall conform to the <u>City's most current eComprehensive pPlan</u> and <u>specifically the Enid area long range tTransportation pPlan, 1994</u>, and shall be considered in their relation to existing and planned streets, to topographical conditions, to public convenience and safety, and in their appropriate relation to the proposed uses of the land to be served by such streets, where not shown on the transportation plan map, the arrangement and other design standards of streets shall conform to the provisions found herein.
- B. Relation <u>Tto</u> Adjoining Street System: The arrangement of streets in a new subdivision shall make provision for the continuation of the existing streets in adjoining areas.
- C. Projection Oof Streets: Where adjoining areas are not subdivided, the arrangement of streets in a new subdivision shall make provisions for the proper projection of streets.
- D. Streets Carried **T**to Property Lines: When a new subdivision adjoins an undeveloped parcel of land susceptible of being subdivided, then the new streets shall be carried to the boundaries of the tract proposed to be subdivided.
 - E. Street Jogs Prohibited: Street jogs at intersections with centerline offsets of less than one hundred feet (100') shall be avoided.

- F. Dead End Street Or Cul-De-Sac: Dead end streets or cul-de-sacs designed to be so permanently, shall not be longer than six hundred feet (600') in length, and shall be provided at the closed end with a turnaround having an outside roadway diameter of at least eighty feet (80'), and a street property line diameter of at least one hundred feet (100'). If a dead end street is of a temporary nature, a similar turnaround shall be provided and provisions made for future extension of the street into adjoining properties. If the cul-de-sac is less than one hundred fifty feet (150') in length, the turnaround may be omitted. Each turnaround may have a center island of not less than twenty feet (20') in diameter. Each island shall be approved with the final plat. Approved islands will be curbed, and if unpaved, any plantings shall not interfere with sight clearance.
 - G. Arterial Streets: Where a subdivision abuts or contains within its boundaries an arterial street which has not been improved to the design standards specified in the Enid area long range transportation plan, 1994City's most current Transportation Plan, an acceldecel turning lane shall be provided where any street within the subdivision intersects the arterial street to afford separation of through and local traffic. This requirement shall not apply to private residential drives.
- H. Local Or Minor Streets: Local streets shall be so laid out that their use by through traffic will be discouraged.
- I. Street Right Oof Way Widths:
 - 1. Street widths shall not be less than as follows:

Street Type	Width (Feet)
Arterial	120
Collector	80
Residential collector	60
Local, apartments	60
Local, all others	50
Cul-de-sac	50
Frontage or marginal access	40

2. In front of areas designated and zoned for commercial use, or where a petition for a change in zoning is contemplated to permit such use, the street width shall be increased by such amount on each side as may be deemed necessary by the

planning commission to assure the free flow of through traffic without interference by parked vehicles and to provide safe parking space for such commercial district.

- J. Intersections: The intersections of more than two (2) streets at one point shall be avoided, except where it is impracticable to secure a proper street system otherwise. Streets shall intersect one another at an angle as near to a right angle as possible, and no intersections of streets at angles less than sixty degrees (60°) shall be approved. Street intersections shall be rounded with a radius of twenty five feet (25') measured at the face of curbs when the said intersection occurs at right angles. If an intersection occurs at an angle other than a right angle, it shall be rounded with a curve of a radius acceptable to the planning commission. In commercial or industrial zoning districts, the planning commission may permit comparable cutoffs or chords.
- K. Street Deflections: When connecting street lines which connect between intersections deflect from each other, they shall be connected by a curve with a radius adequate to ensure a sight distance of not less than two hundred feet (200').
- L. Reverse Curves: A tangent shall be introduced between reverse curves on arterial and collector streets sufficient to provide for the smooth flow of traffic.
- M. Subdivision Linto Tracts Larger Than Ordinary Building Lots: Where a tract is subdivided into larger parcels than are ordinarily permitted, such parcels shall be arranged so as to allow the opening of future streets and logical further resubdivision.
- N. Reserve Strips: Reserve strips controlling access to streets shall be prohibited, except under conditions approved by the planning commission and when such strips are owned by the eCity.
- O. Ingress Aand Egress: Ingress and egress to residential property shall not be provided on arterial streets.
 - P. Street Grades: No street grade shall be less than three-tenths of one percent (0.3%), and shall not exceed eight percent (8%) or eleven percent (11%) on local streets, with due allowance for reasonable vertical curves.
- Q. Railroad Or Highway Abutting Subdivision: Where a subdivision borders on or contains a railroad right of way or limited access highway right of way, the planning commission may require a street approximately parallel to, and on each side of, such right of way, at a distance suitable for the appropriate use of the intervening land, or for park purposes in residential districts, or for commercial or industrial purposes in appropriate districts. Such distance shall also be determined with due regard for the requirements of approach grades and future grade separations.
- R. Half Streets Prohibited: Half streets shall be prohibited, except where essential to the reasonable development of the subdivision in conformity with the other requirements of

these regulations and where the planning commission finds it will be practicable to require the dedication of the other half when the adjoining property is subdivided. Wherever a half street is adjacent to a tract to be subdivided, the other half of the street shall be platted within such tract.

- S. Street Names Aand Numbers: Names of new streets shall not duplicate existing or platted street names unless a new street is a continuation of, or in alignment with, the existing or platted street. All street names shall be subject to approval by the planning commission. So far as practicable, street names shall be grouped in categories and names within a category shall be used in only one area of the city, streets which continue in a straight line shall continue with the same name; streets which curve to the extent that they intersect with other parallel streets shall have a separate name for that portion of the street. House numbers shall be assigned by the eCode aAdministration dDepartment of the eCity.
- T. Access Tto Streets Across Ditches: The subdivider shall provide access to all proposed streets, across all ditches, in a standard method approved by the director of engineering services.
- U. Vacation Oof Streets: The Metropolitan Area pPlanning eCommission shall not recommend the vacation of any street or part of a street dedicated for public use, if such vacation interferes with the uniformity of the existing street pattern or any future street plan prepared for the area.
- V. Private Streets: Public improvements shall not be approved for any private street or drive, unless expressly <u>recommended for approvedal</u> by the <u>Metropolitan Area pP</u>lanning <u>eCommission</u>.
- W. Hardship **T**to Owners **O**of Adjoining Property Avoided: The street arrangement shall not be such as to cause hardship to owners of adjoining property in platting their own land and providing convenient access to it.
- X. Street Interval: In general, provisions should be made for through streets at intervals not exceeding one-half $\binom{1}{2}$ mile along arterial streets.
- Y. Sidewalks: Sidewalks must comply with the Americans with disabilities act (the ADA) and section 12-8-7 of this title. All commercial developments which abut Owen K. Garriott Road, Van Buren Street, an arterial highway, an auxiliary service highway, an arterial street or a collector street must include sidewalks that parallel those streets. Industrial developments where sidewalks are planned for the street that runs parallel to the development must incorporate sidewalks into its development. Redevelopment of residential subdivisions that were originally developed with sidewalks must include sidewalks:shall be required pursuant to Section 10-6-1 of this Code and shall comply with Section 12-8-7 of this Code.-(Ord. 2011-16, 10-18-2011)

<u>Section IV</u>: That Title 12, Chapter 8, Section 12-8-7, of the Enid Municipal Code, 2014, is hereby amended to read as follows:

12-8-7: SIDEWALK CONSTRUCTION PLANS:

- A. The maximum slope of a sidewalk is one to twenty (1:20) or five percent (5%). Sidewalks with slopes greater than one to twenty (1:20) or five percent (5%) are considered ramps and must comply with the ADA, the ADA accessibility guidelines for buildings and facilities (ADAAG), most current accessibility guidelines associated with the Americans with Disabilities Act or regulations promulgated by the dDepartment of Justice for ramps.
 - 1. Exception: Sidewalks that run parallel to a street may have a grade matching the road grade.
- B. The surface of the sidewalk must be paved and slip resistant with no changes in level greater than one-fourth inch $\binom{1}{4}$ ").
- C. The plans must include curb ramps with detectable warnings, any necessary signals or signage and for residential subdivisions it must include a plan for each individual lot.
- D. The minimum clear width of sidewalks that run parallel to local streets is forty eight inches (48") and along other roads the minimum clear width is sixty inches (60").
- E. Every sidewalk must provide a clear passing width of at least sixty inches by sixty inches (60" x 60") located at intervals not to exceed two hundred feet (200').
- F. Driveway crossings must not create a cross slope for the sidewalk of more than two one and one-half percent (21½%).
- G. The minimum headroom is eighty inches (80").
- H. Gratings may not have openings greater than one-half inch $(^1/_2")$ and the long dimension of the openings must run perpendicular to the direction of travel.
- I. Sidewalks that include directional signs must include Braille with the baseline of the tactile characters between forty eight inches (48") and sixty inches (60").
- J. Curb ramps should be designed consistent with the following:
 - 1. Provide a level maneuvering area at the top of the curb ramp;
 - 2. Clearly identify the boundary between the bottom of the curb ramp and the street with a detectable warning that extends the full width of the ramp and runs for twenty four inches (24") from the bottom of the ramp;
 - 3. Place the curb ramp within the marked crosswalk area;

- 4. Design the ramp so that it does not require turning or maneuvering on the ramp surface;
- 5. Design the ramp with a maximum grade of 8.37.1 percent;
- 6. Design the ramp and gutter with a cross slope of two one and one-half percent (21½%) maximum;
- 7. Provide adequate drainage to prevent accumulation of water or debris at the bottom of the ramp;
- 8. Transitions from ramps to gutter and streets are flush and free of level changes; and
- 9. Align the curb ramps with the crosswalk so there is a straight path of travel from the top of the ramp to the center of the roadway to the curb ramp on the other side.
- K. Detectable warnings for curb ramps should consist of truncated domes with:
 - 1. A bottom diameter of twenty three millimeters (23 mm) (0.9 inch);
 - 2. A top diameter of ten millimeters (10 mm) (0.4 inch);
 - 3. A height of five millimeters (5 mm) (0.2 inch);
 - 4. A center to center spacing of sixty millimeters (60 mm) (2.35 inches); and
 - 5. A visual contrast from the adjacent pavement.
- L. When sidewalks are being constructed or modified along streets that have already been constructed, these standards may need to be modified to adjust to the particular layout of the land, property, street and utilities. Care should be taken to ensure accessibility is enhanced and not diminished by construction but strict compliance may not be feasible. In these circumstances parallel curb ramps, blended transitions, or other designs may be utilized. (Ord. 2009-09, 4-7-2009)

<u>Section V</u>: Repealer. All ordinances or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with this ordinance, are hereby repealed.

<u>Section VI</u>: Savings Clause. Nothing in this ordinance hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceedings now pending in any court, or any rights acquired or liability incurred, nor any cause or causes of action accrued or existing, under any act or ordinance repealed hereby. Nor shall any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this ordinance.

<u>Section VII</u>: Severability. If any one or more of the sections, sentences, clauses or parts of this ordinance, chapter or section shall, for any reason, be held invalid, the invalidity of such section, clause or part shall not affect or prejudice in any way the applicability and validity of any other provision of this ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Commission of the City of Enid that this section of the Enid Municipal Code would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part not been included.

<u>Section VIII</u>: Codification. This ordinance shall be codified as Title 10, Chapter 4, Section 10-4-3, Title 10, Chapter 6, Sections 10-6-1 and 10-6-2, Title 12, Chapter 6, Section 12-6-2 and Title 12, Chapter 8, Section 12-8-7 of the Enid Municipal Code, 2014.
