SPECIAL NOTICES	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Wind speed must be below 10 miles per hour and there must be a relative humidity above 30%. There can be no Burn Ban or Red Flag Fire Alert in effect.2. You must have enough manpower and equipment on hand at all times to contain the fire on your property. <u>Fire must not be left unattended.</u>3. If the smoke obscures a roadway or presents a hazard the fire must be extinguished.4. You must call the Enid Fire Department at 580-242-7000 each time you begin to burn and again when the fire has been extinguished. You must immediately call the Fire Department emergency number (9-1-1) if the fire gets out of control5. You must have this permit at the burn site for inspection.6. Complaints to the Fire Department regarding smoke, blowing embers, etc. will result in the fire units being dispatched to extinguish the fire. A new Burn Permit will be required to continue the burn at a later date.7. Willful violation of these conditions could result in fines and possibly even criminal prosecution as provided by City Ordinance.
