<u>BACKGROUND</u>: With continued national reach of touring entertainment options ranging from concerts to family shows to other diverse events, the EECCH has seen the opportunity of self-promoting events, primarily at Enid Event Center. Booking of these events (and a greater amount of events in general) require additional appropriation of expenses, totaling an estimated \$800,000.00. Examples of the driving factor expenses are: artist fees, production costs, stagehand labor, F&B costs, and the like. More importantly, these events allowed EECCH to drive direct (over \$1.3m in gross ticket sales in FY14) and ancillary event revenue to a positive net cash flow scenario on events. The original budget included more "rentals" where the promoter (not the venue) was responsible for payment of such expenses. EECCH has seen strategic opportunities to self-promote, which has allowed the diversity of event mix to be high and EECCH to benefit financially.

Based on additional revenues generated, funds are available for appropriation from the Enid Event Center and Convention Hall Fund.

2013-2014 BUDGETED ITEM: No. This item increases the Enid Event Center and Convention Hall budget.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: This project concerned the 2013 water meter maintenance program, and consisted of repairing water leaks. The original contract amount was \$67,200.00 with a Change Order No. 1 in the amount of \$9,770.00, for a total cost of \$76,970.00. The actual total cost was \$76,238.90. This item will deduct the remaining balance of \$731.10 and accept the project. A total of 22 water meter maintenance jobs were budgeted for the water meter maintenance program and change order. A total of 54 water meter maintenance jobs were completed.

9.2 CLOSE PROJECT WITH SUMMIT CIVIL CONTRACTORS, LLC, TULSA, OKLAHOMA, FOR THE ENID RENAISSANCE EARTHWORK, SITE CLEARING, SOIL EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL, PROJECT NO. M-1109E, BID PACKAGE #1-2A.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: The Enid Renaissance Project required site clearing and soil erosion steps prior to the construction of the new Event Center and renovation of Convention Hall. Summit Civil Contractors, LLC was awarded this bid package in the amount of \$368,500.00, of which \$302,385.15 has been paid.

Summit Civil Contractors did not complete the project, and final work was completed by a general contractor.

This item will deduct the remaining balance of \$66,114.85 and close out this project.

9.6 AWARD THE PURCHASE OF A POWER CONCRETE CURBER MACHINE WITH MONOLITHIC CURB AND GUTTER MOLDS TO GOMACO CORPORATION, IDA GROVE, IOWA.

<u>BACKGROUND</u>: Bids were sent on May 25, 2014, for a Power Concrete Curber Machine. An alternate bid was also requested for a Power Concrete Curber Machine with Monolithic Curb and Gutter Molds.

Two (2) bids were received:

Power Curbers, Inc.	\$ 280,600.00	\$ 289,100.00
GOMACO Corporation	\$ 269,250.00	\$ 278,625.00

Power Curbers Inc. met all of the bid specifications. GOMACO Corporation met all but the engine specifications. GOMACO's Power Curb Machine works off of a conveyor belt system vs. the Power Curber's auger system. An auger system requires more horse power than a conveyor system to operate the Power Curb Equipment. GOMACO's engine size is 125 HP vs. Power Curber's 130 HP.

GOMACO Corporation submitted the lowest bid in the amount of \$278,625.00.

The Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the City of Enid, County of Garfield, State of

Oklahoma, the Trustees of the Enid Municipal Authority, a Public Trust, and the Trustees of the Enid

Economic Development Authority, a Public Trust, met in regular meeting in the Council Chambers of the

Administration Building of the City of Enid, located at 401 West Owen K. Garriott Road in said city, at

6:30 P.M. on the 3rd day of June 2014, pursuant to notice given by December 15, 2013 to the Clerk of the

City of Enid, and pursuant to notice thereof displayed at the entrance to the Administration Building of

said city, in prominent view and which notice was posted prior to 5:00 P.M. on the 2nd day of June 2014.

Mayor Shewey called the meeting to order with the following members present and absent:

PRESENT: Commissioners Janzen, Ezzell, Timm, Wilson, Vanhooser and Mayor Shewey.

ABSENT: Commissioner Stuber.

Chief Joe Jackson, Director of Marketing and Public Relations Steve Kime, Human Resources Director

Sonya Key, Director of Aviation Dan Ohnesorge, and Ex-Officio Member Col. Darren James.

Pastor Noah Bailey from Enid Reformed Presbyterian Church gave the Invocation, and Mr. Rob

Camp led the Flag Salute.

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Motion was made by Commissioner Janzen and seconded by Commissioner Timm to approve the minutes of the regular Commission meeting of May 20, 2014, and the special meeting of May 22, 2014, and the vote was as follows:

AYE: Commissioners Janzen, Ezzell, Timm, Wilson, Vanhooser and Mayor Shewey.

NAY: None.

Mr. Gene Robertson presented a two-month old female mixed Shepherd, available for adoption at the Enid Animal Shelter.

Ms. Bailey Wilson was recognized for being selected as a member of Youth Leadership Oklahoma. Ms. Wilson, one (1) of three (3) Enid youths selected to participate in the program, will join other youth leaders and spend June 8–June 13, 2014 traveling to selected locations in Oklahoma, learning about and experiencing Oklahoma's treasures, meeting adult community and state leaders, and developing personal leadership skills.

A legislative update was provided by Mr. Curt Roggow, Legislative Liaison, who spoke on several issues related to municipal government that were among the over 400 bills passed and signed into law during the 54th Oklahoma legislative session. Bills of local interest discussed by Mr. Roggow were those regarding water grant funding, sales tax retention, water reuse, vapor products, military/municipal sales tax, and housing incentives.

Brief discussion was held regarding the final plat of Stonebridge Development, Lot 1, Block 1, located at the northwest corner of West Chestnut Street and North Cleveland Avenue. It was noted that the Metropolitan Area Planning Commission unanimously recommended approval of the final plat at its meeting of May 19, 2014.

Motion was made by Commissioner Wilson and seconded by Commissioner Ezzell to approve

the Final Plat as presented, and the vote was as follows:

AYE: Commissioners Janzen, Ezzell, Timm, Wilson, Vanhooser and Mayor Shewey.

Motion was made by Commissioner Janzen and seconded by Commissioner Vanhooser to

approve the final plat for Tara Estates, Blocks 4, 5 and 6, located at the southwest corner of North

Oakwood Road and West Purdue Avenue. It was noted that the Metropolitan Area Planning Commission

unanimously recommended approval of the final plat at its meeting of May 19, 2014.

Brief discussion was held regarding a resolution approving, adopting and appropriating the 2014-

2015 Fiscal Budget for the City of Enid; approving the Fiscal Year 2014-2015 financial plans for the Enid

Public Transportation and Vance Development authorities; authorizing the City Manager, or his designee,

to make fund transfers as provided in the Municipal Budget Act; and authorizing the Chief Financial

Officer to invest the City's funds as provided in Oklahoma Statute Title 62, Section 348.1.

A brief review of the proposed budget, depicting \$162 million in budgeted revenues and \$167

million in budgeted expenses, was presented by Chief Financial Officer Jerald Gilbert.

Commissioner Vanhooser commented that this was as close to an ideal neutral revenue budget

that he had seen in his two (2) years on the Council. He stated that the budget represented barely over one

percent (1%) of a deficit, and commended the Commission and staff, stating that this was an excellent

compromise on everyone's part.

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Motion was then made by Commissioner Wilson and seconded by Commissioner Ezzell to approve the resolution as presented.

Commissioner Vanhooser asked if Commissioner Wilson would modify her motion to include the

Commission's intent to have a full review of the budget at the six-month mark.

Commissioner Wilson amended her motion to approve said resolution as presented, with a full review of the budget at the six-month mark.

Commissioner Ezzell amended his second, and the vote was as follows:

AYE: Commissioners Janzen, Ezzell, Wilson, Vanhooser and Mayor Shewey.

NAY: Commissioner Timm.

Discussion was held regarding an ordinance amending Section 2-6E-10 in Article E, Chapter 6, Title 2 of the Enid Municipal Code, 2003, entitled "Stormwater Development Fees."

City Engineer Robert Hitt explained that the proposed ordinance would change stormwater development fees for multi-family, commercial, industrial and other assessments from an estimated impervious per acre fee, to a measured square foot impervious surface fee. No changes would be made with respect to estate and residential stormwater development fees.

Motion was made by Commissioner Timm and seconded by Commissioner Janzen to approve said ordinance as presented, and the vote was as follows:

ORDINANCE NO. 2014-25

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ENID MUNICIPAL CODE, 2003, TITLE 2, ENTITLED "FINANCE AND TAXATION," CHAPTER 6, ENTITLED "FEE SCHEDULE," ARTICLE E, ENTITLED UTILITIES FEES AND CHARGES," SECTION 2-6E-10, ENTITLED "STORMWATER DEVELOPMENT FEES," TO CHANGE THE CALCULATION OF FEES FOR MULTI-FAMILY, COMMERCIAL/INDUSTRIAL OR

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OTHER FROM A PER-ACRE FEE TO A PER-SQUARE FOOT OF IMPERVIOUS SURFACE FEE AND TO ADJUST THE FEES TO 2013 RATES; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER, SAVINGS CLAUSE, SEVERABILITY, AND CODIFICATION.

Motion was made by Commissioner Vanhooser and seconded by Commissioner Janzen to award a contract for Project M-1412A, Replacement of HVAC Units at the Enid Police Department, to the lowest, responsible bidder, Dense Mechanical Contractors, Enid, Oklahoma, in the amount of \$81,820.00, and the vote was as follows:

AYE: Commissioners Janzen, Ezzell, Timm, Wilson, Vanhooser and Mayor Shewey.

NAY: None.

Discussion was held regarding a franchise agreement with Oklahoma Natural Gas Company (ONG).

City Attorney Andrea Chism explained that ONG had held a franchise with the City of Enid since 1990, which would expire in January 2015. She stated that she and Assistant City Manager Joan Riley had met with ONG representatives, and had been presented with their proposal for a new franchise agreement. She advised commissioners that language had been added to the agreement that representatives of ONG stated were non-negotiable. Of note were the following suggestions by ONG: 1) No change in the franchise fee; 2) Revised buy-out language which was less favorable to the City; and 3) A 25-year agreement.

Ms. Riley stated that conversations with ONG had ended in an impasse. She went on to say that ONG would not budge on what they were offering, and would go no further without a ruling from the Commission.

Ms. Chism stated that as a result, the proposal was being brought to commissioners for consideration as to whether or not they wanted to accept ONG's offer, or if they wanted to send it back to ONG for continued negotiations.

Motion was made by Commissioner Vanhooser to deny the agreement.

Motion was seconded by Commissioner Ezzell.

Commissioner Ezzell stated that there was no chance he would approve the buy-out language proposed by ONG, and suggested this might be a scenario where counsel, who had experience in negotiating this scale of agreement, was hired to take on the negotiations. He went on to say he was not enthusiastic about the prospect of buying the gas company at the moment, but went on to say that there was no way to predict what it would be in 25 years, and did not want to hamstring the next City Commission with that level of restriction. He added that going forward, the City needed to make sure that it was ensuring that it could execute its rights under the franchise agreement as currently stated.

Notification requirements to ONG regarding the City's intent were discussed. It was noted that if commissioners rejected ONG's offer, then the City was required to notify ONG by July 1, 2014.

Following further discussion, the vote was taken as follows:

AYE: Commissioners Janzen, Ezzell, Timm, Wilson and Vanhooser.

NAY: Mayor Shewey.

The motion to deny the franchise agreement with Oklahoma Natural Gas was approved.

Motion was made by Commissioner Ezzell and seconded by Commissioner Janzen to select the firm of Strategic Government Resources (SGR), Keller, Texas, to assist the Commission in the city manager hiring effort.
